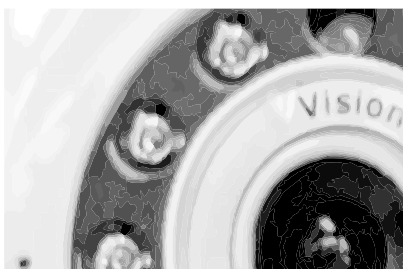

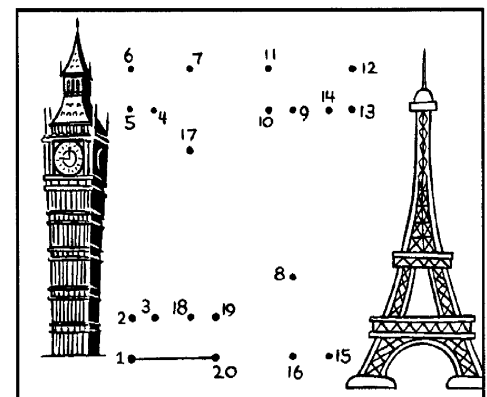

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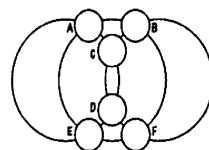
WHAT PART of London is in France? Connect the dots and find out.

THREE-RING CIRCUS!

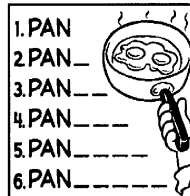
Place the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 into the small circles so that the four numbers, on the rim of any ring, add up to 14.



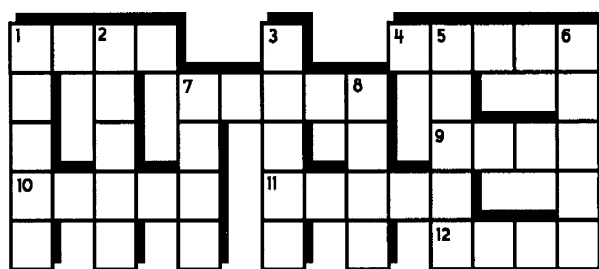
One Answer: A=5, B=4, C=1, D=6, E=2, F=3.

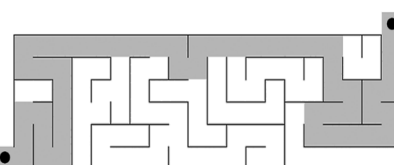

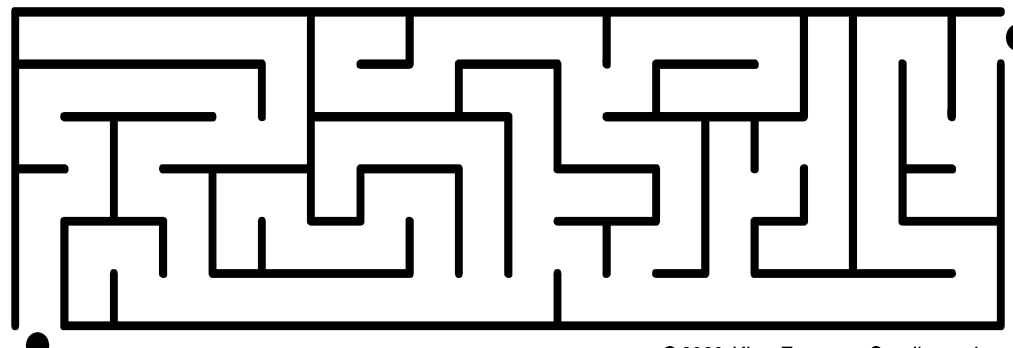
