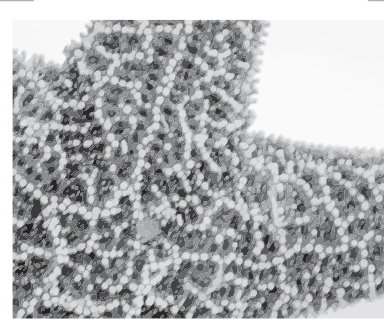

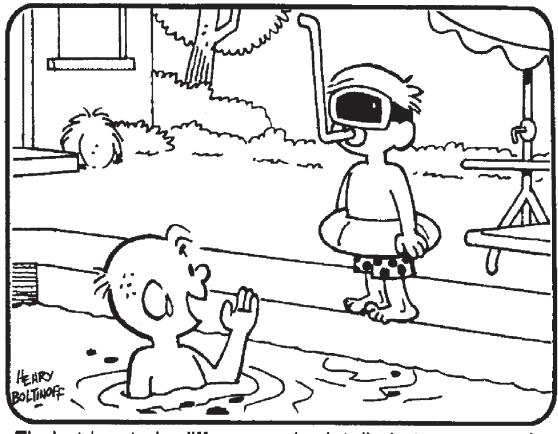

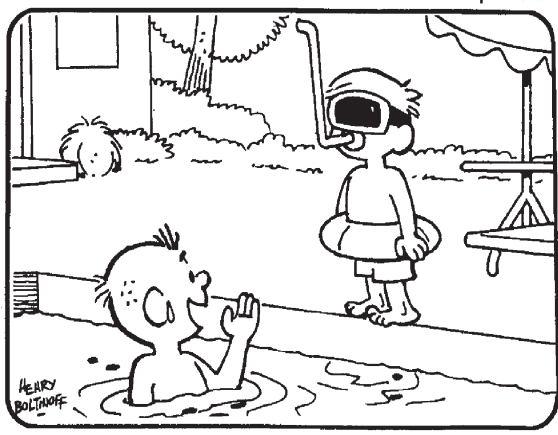

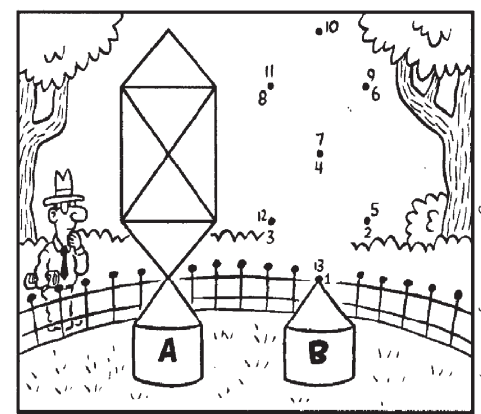

Answers: Day 1, \$8; Day 2, \$14; Day 3, \$20; Day 4, \$26; Day 5, \$32.

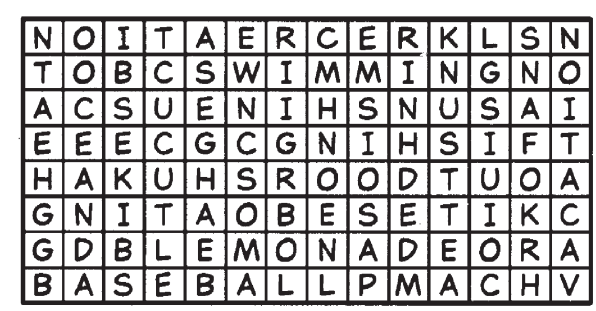

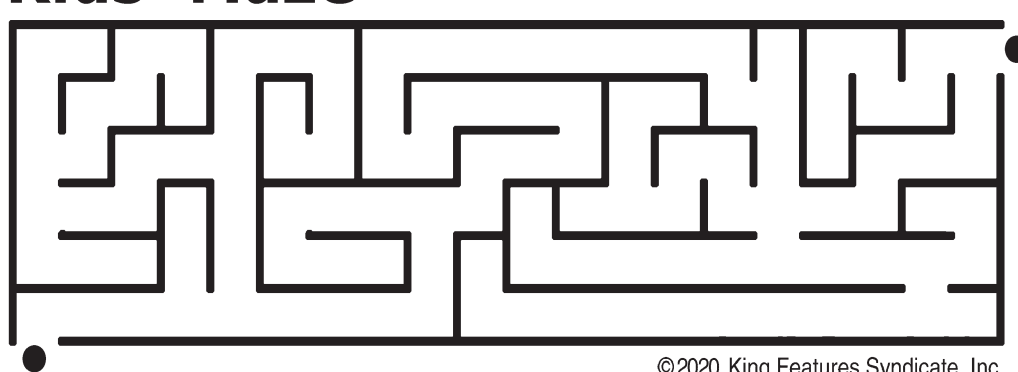
