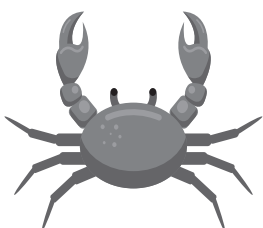

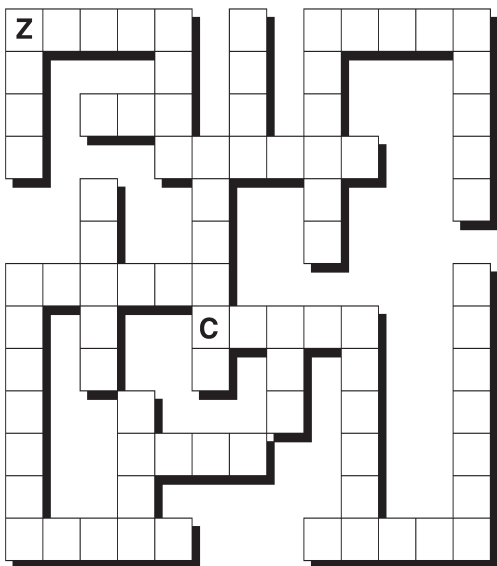

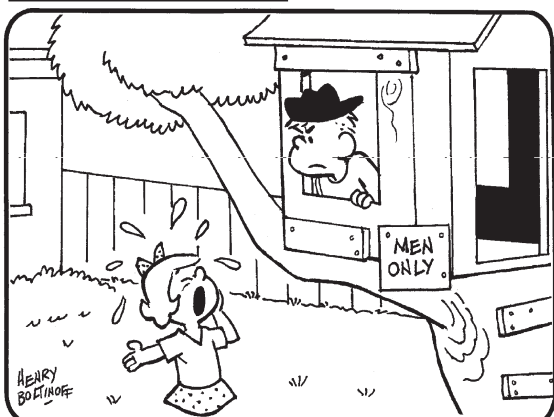

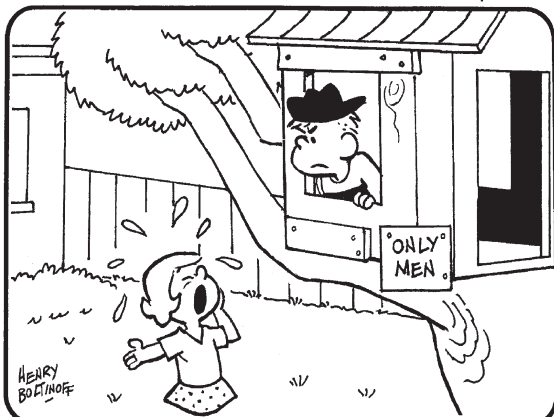
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HOCUS-FOCUS

Answer: 1 + 2 + 2 + 34 + 56 + 7 = 100.

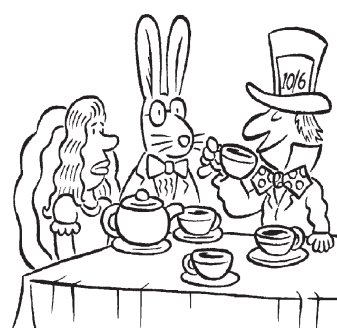

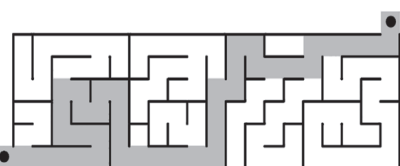

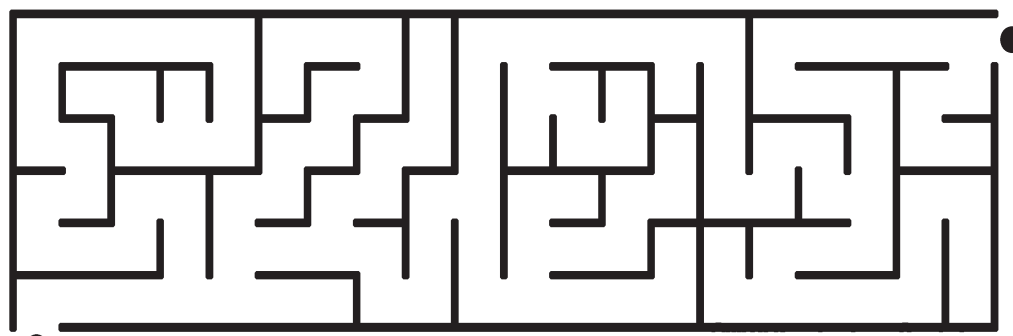
