as planning and developing services for older persons in Douglas County.

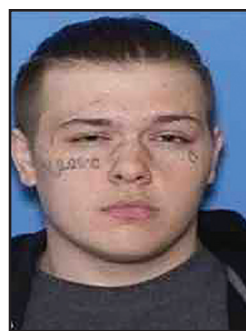
Meetings are held quarterly on the second Wednesday of March, June, September and December at 1:30 p.m.

Garrett is approximately 6'6" and about 180 pounds.

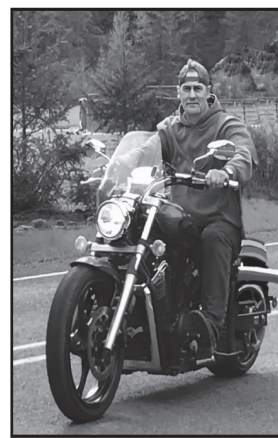
