## LRAPA warns of smoke from Beachie Creek Fire

The Lane Regional Air Protection Agency (LRAPA) that some areas in Lane County may see "Unhealthy" or "Very Unhealthy" air on the Air Quality Index.

Closing all doors and windows through the night is recommended.

The Beachie Creek Fire is a 513 acres wildfire east of Salem and north of Detroit, Oregon. Dry northeasterly winds will push smoke into Lane County through Friday.

Pollutants in smoke can cause burning eyes, runny nose, and aggravate heart and lung diseases and other serious health problems.

Avoid strenuous outdoor activity. Stay indoors if possible, and keep windows and doors closed.

Use high efficiency particulate air (HEPA) Filters if possible. Please follow medical advice if you have a heart or lung conditions.

Smoke can irritate the eyes and lungs and worsen some medical conditions. Young children, adults over 65, pregnant women, and people with heart disease, asthma or other respiratory conditions are most at risk.

Protect your health when smoke levels are high:

Stay inside if possible and keep windows and doors closed.
