With COVID-19 transmission falling in Lane County, PeaceHealth will ease its temporary "no-visitor" policy at all four Oregon hospitals to allow one visitor per day, per patient, with some limited exceptions.

For patients suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, the no-visitor policy remains, with limited exceptions.

This change was effective March 8 and applies to PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center at RiverBend; PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center, University District; PeaceHealth Cottage Grove Community Medical Center; and Peace-Health Peace Harbor Medical Center.

PeaceHealth Medical Group clinics will continue to limit visitors to only those accompanying patients needing assistance.

The change in hospital visitation aims to balance safety with patient, caregiver and visitor well-being and satisfaction.

She graduated high school in New Jersey. Georgia married Jack Evan January 4, 1960 in New Jersey, they later divorced.


Georgia held clerical jobs and retired from WalMart.
