Filing deadline for Special Election approaches

May 18 is the next election date in Lane County. Filing deadlines for the Tuesday, May 18, Special Election is March 18. People can still run for positions on several local boards, including school districts, emergency response departments and

Public Works releases February Building Division report

For the month of February, the Building Division of the Cottage Grove Public Works and Development Department issued 37 permits, two for single-family homes, and

performed 101 inspections in Cottage Grove. In Creswell, 21 permits were issued and 55 inspections were performed. In Veneta, 15 permits

were issued and 123 inspections were performed. In Coburg 13 permits were issued, two for new single-family homes, and 22 inspections were per-

formed. Staff reviewed and approved 20 plan sets in February and 15 plan sets are in review or on hold for more information.

PeaceHealth Oregon eases hospital visitation restrictions

With COVID-19 transmission falling in Lane County, PeaceHealth will ease its temporary “no-visitor” policy at all four Oregon hospitals to allow one visitor per day, per patient, with some limited exceptions. For patients suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, the no-visitor policy remains, with limited exceptions.

PeaceHealth will continue to monitor the local prevalence of COVID-19 and will tighten rules again if necessary. While most patients will be allowed only one designated visitor per day, two may be allowed for patients at end-of-life as well as minors, including infants in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. Patients

with disabilities may be allowed up to three support persons. Most hospitalized patients with confirmed COVID-19 are not allowed visitors. Minors, Labor & Delivery and end-of-life patients may have one visitor. Any exceptions to the policy will be made at the discretion of PeaceHealth

clinical care leadership. Visitors must wear a mask at all times and will be asked to limit their movement throughout the hospitals.
