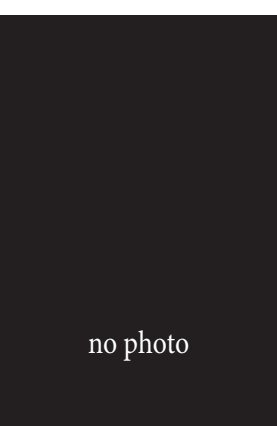
March Student of the Month is La Rissa Chancellor nominated by Joey Vanek

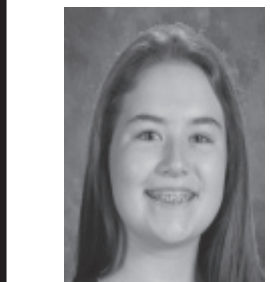
