### Summer restrictions in place at wastewater treatment plant

ment Plant has gone into the summer thermal limits required by the Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

Now through May 15, limits are 13 million Kcals/day. This is the allowed increase in

The Wastewater Treat- temperature caused by the fish spawning season. Sept. 15, the NPDES pertreated water being released into the river by the treatment plant.

> Due to the restriction, the City is unable to discharge all its treated effluent into the river. This is to keep the river cooler for fish migration.


