- Curbside pickup and homebound services

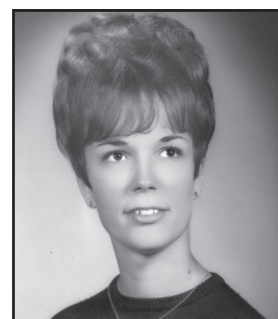
- will still continue
