offense was moving the ball down the field and was within eight yards of the endzone to start the second quarter. A minute into the second quarter, Camden Galen took a pitch on the outside for Newport and ran in a score from eight yards out (7-0 Newport).

Nelson and the Lions got the ball back near midfield and were able to move the ball down to the goal line again.

But Nelson would lose the ball and the Cubs would recover the fumble at their own four-yard-line. Two plays later Tyler Mattson connected with his receiver Kaden Bruns for a 64-yard score, growing the Newport lead in the second quarter (14-0 Newport).

On the next Cottage Grove drive Nelson would find his receiver Hayden Pe-

tersen for almost a 30-yard gain and a penalty against the Newport defense put the ball at the Newport 9-yard-line.

Nelson ran three times and successfully capped off a score for Cottage Grove (14-7 Newport).

The Cottage Grove defense would force a turnover on the next offensive series for Newport with Myles Julien intercepting the Newport quarterback.

Nelson connected on another deep pass, this time with Brayden Crump for a 28-yard gain down to the Newport 17. Nelson again would have success running the ball against the Cubs defense as he ran in another score tying the game just before halftime (14-14).

With less than 30 seconds left in the half Mattson heaved a pass and found his receiver running down the sideline for a 70-yard score to end the half with a Newport lead (21-14 Newport).

helping cut the Siuslaw lead to four at 20-16. But Siuslaw wouldn't get rattled as they responded with back-to-back points of their own making the Vikings lead 22-16.

Peyton Kidd and Senters both had aces near the end of the set keeping the score tight at 24-21. Senters' last serve of the set went out of bounds to give Siuslaw the first set win 25-21.

Taylor McKay had a quality serve to make the Cottage Grove lead 15-11. Arnold would put up three points in a row followed by a timely point by Kidd would increase the Lions lead even more at 23-17.

A Siuslaw hit out of bounds and a Cottage Grove block at the net would close the third set for the Lions at 25-18, who were on the verge of their league title with a two to one set lead.

On the ensuing kickoff, Nelson returned the kick deep into the Newport territory and Tucker two plays later would rush for a five-yard score (27-21 Newport).

With positive momentum still on their side, Siuslaw got an early 6-3 lead after a hit by Blake and an ace from Manues. The Lions refused to let the game get away from them as Arnold served two aces in a row tying the set back up at six.

After a mistake by Siuslaw, the Lions had a 9-6 lead looking to close out the set, but the Vikings again

would rally and score three points of their own to tie the set again at nine. Both teams would not give an inch as the scoring went back and forth until 12-12. However, Siuslaw had a serve go out of bounds and Arnold made a huge hit, giving the Lions a 14-12 lead.

The Vikings were able to score, putting even more pressure on the Lions with a one-point lead. In the next rally, Arnold would get blocked at the net but the Lions recovered; Kidd was able to set up Arnold one more time, who hit the ball off the Siuslaw block for the game-winning point and bringing in a 15-13 set win for the Lions.

"This group of seniors were my first JV team that I coached on my own," said Ladd. "I've been with this group of seniors and all of the other girls on the team since their first day. And so I am just overflowing with joy and pride in how they have grown over the past four years as volleyball players and people."
