RESUME'S NET LIMITED.

Southern Pacific's Famous Flyer Starts From San Francisco, December 15th.

"The Sunset Limited, the Southern Pacific's famous train of the Sunset route, will commence its service for the winter season on Friday, December 15th. This schedule for this year is particularly favorable as it will afford a view of the bay, and making agreeable connections at New Orleans with limited trains of other lines to and from the important centers of the east.

The train will leave San Francisco at 5 P. M. on Tuesdays and Fridays, passing Los Angeles about 7 o'clock the following morning, thus giving a day-light view of the orange belt of Southern California.
