MINES & MINING.

Devoted to Bohemia Notes and Mining Items of General Interest to Mining Men.

Messrs. Wilks and Huston, were observed crossing Row river last week to their placer diggings near Halls place where it is said they have something great.

Tuesday four four-horse freight wagons, and 25 men besides two stage loads of passengers from the Fashion stables, started for the mines. Business has commenced now for good and in two weeks there will be from 75 to 150 freight teams on the road daily.

Ernest Lockwood bought in a sample of ore from his property in Bohemia that helps to show the richness of the district. The ore was assayed by Frank P. White and showed \$453 in gold and silver besides several per cent of copper and lead. Ernest is well pleased with the showings of this ledge and will push development work during the summer.

Alex Pugh is reported having made a rich strike on the east side of Adams Mountain recently. The strike is free milling ore and is said to be rich as the great free milling lead in the Helena.

E. S. Adams the well known mining man has just entered into a deal that will in all probability materialize into another substantial company in the near future. Mr. Adams has just purchased from Attorney J. E. Young the "Fisaur" claim for \$900.00, and taken a lease with deed in escrow for two others adjoining and owned by Messrs. Higgins, Young and Jenks. Mr. Adams has also leased with deed in escrow two other claims adjoining belonging to Messrs. Howard and Rathburne. This makes all told a group of five claims. These claims are situated at the base of Elephant Mountain and are considered a very valuable property. Mr. Adams left for Portland Thursday where he will complete further arrangements looking forward to speedy development of the property. He also contemplates the erection of a smelter at no distant day.
