intimated that France may set the Monroe doctrine to a large tract of land in Brazil. Of course, French capitalists may invest money in land in Brazil and a transaction would not count in this country. But it is intimated in this case that France proposes to purchase the sovereignty of the land purchased by French capitalists, which would be quite another thing. The Monroe doctrine is based upon two principles—first, that European powers shall not extend their system of government to the Western Hemisphere, and, second, that the Western Hemisphere is no longer open to colonization by European powers. As France is a republic, the Monroe doctrine might not apply to it; but as it is a European power, it certainly would. The pending transaction is the purchase of 100,000 square miles of land. If France should acquire sovereignty, it would possess the basis of a colony half as large as France itself, and larger than several European powers. As Brazil is in a measure protected by the Monroe doctrine, it is probable that she will decline to dispose of the sovereignty of any other territory.—Bulletin.
