MARRIAGE LAWS.

To a letter of inquiry to the Oregonian that paper gives a very interesting summary of the statutes in effect in Oregon:

The marriage laws of this state are too long and involved to justify publication. Condensed, the requirements are (after securing the girl and a license from the county clerk in the county where the female resides, which license must be sworn to by one witness other than the party seeking the license, who knows the girl, and costs \$2.25) that the man shall be over the age of 18 years, and the female over the age of 15. If, however, the male be under 21 years of age or the female under 18 the county clerk is forbidden to issue the license without the written consent of the parents or guardian of the boy between 18 and 21 or the girl between 15 and 18.

Marriages may be solemnized by any minister or priest of any church or religious organization or congregation in this state anywhere in this state, according to the established ritual or form commonly practiced therein or the ceremony may be performed by any judicial officer within his jurisdiction. The United States allows captains of seagoing vessels to marry couples outside the three mile limit. The officiating clergyman or officer must not perform the ceremony unless the parties have a license, and shall keep the same, but must within a month deliver or mail to the county clerk who issued the license, a certificate required by law, and shall also give to each of the parties, if required, a certificate of marriage, specifying therein the names and residence of the parties, and of at least two witnesses present, the time and place of such marriage, and the date of the license therefor, and by whom issued.

No particular form of marriage ceremony is required, except that the parties thereunto shall freely consent to the marriage in the presence of the clergyman or officer and at least two witnesses, and shall declare that they take each other to be husband and wife.

The laws prohibit marriages when either party has a wife or husband then living or when the parties are nearer of kin to each other than first cousins, or under age, or when one is an idiot or is insane, or when either of the parties is a white person and the other is negro, Chinese or any person having one-fourth or more negro, Chinese or Kanaka blood, or any person having more than one-half Indian blood.

ACQUISITION OF TERRITORY.

The Oregonian last week kindly furnished the following information to one of its inquirers which is good for all to know:

December 20, 1803, the United States bought Louisiana from France for \$12,000,000. The Louisiana purchase included the whole or part of the present states of Arkansas, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, Oregon, the two Dakotas, Washington, Wyoming, Idaho, Indian Territory and Oklahoma.

October 24, 1820, Spain ceded Florida, including what is the southern extremities of Alabama and Mississippi, to the United States.

Texas and parts of New Mexico, Colorado and Wyoming were annexed December 29, 1845.

California, Arizona, Nevada and Utah and parts of Wyoming, Colorado and New Mexico were ceded by Mexico February 2, 1840.

The Gadsden purchase acquired a strip of land now forming a part of the southern extremities of New Mexico and Arizona was made December 30, 1853.

October 1, 1867, Alaska was purchased from Russia for \$7,200,000.

December 10, 1898, the Philippine Islands and Porto Rico were acquired by treaty with Spain.
