Mines and Mining Devoted to Bohemia Notes and Items of general interest to Mining Men. An Interview With Lloyd.

The following dispatch to the New York Commercial is self explanatory. Boston, June 22.—The recent publication of an article relative to the development of the Bohemia section of Oregon has aroused considerable interest in this section, and George W. Lloyd, a well known mining engineer of Boston, who is also president of the Crystal Consolidated Mining Co. and general manager of the Bohemia Gold Mining Co., has this to say on the section: "The Helena has been fortunate enough to have quite an amount of free milling ore, and the company has kept its mill running nearly all the time on this ore for the past two years and more. The No. 20 stamp mill of 20 stamps has not been in operation for more than three years. The Musick mill of 15 stamps has not been in operation for 18 months. The Champion mill of 10 stamps has not been in operation for several years, and the machinery is in a very bad condition. "Some of the surface ores carry gold in a free form on many of the mining claims. On the Musick there was quite an amount of it, and a stamp mill was placed on the property several years ago. This stamp mill successfully treated the ore, and many thousands of dollars were made for the owners. This ore practically has been exhausted, and the ores remaining are of a base nature and require concentration and smelting. "There is one shoot of free-milling ore known as the Rich Shoot, which seems to go down into the earth below the present working. The sixth level of the mine is being extended to intersect this shoot, and it is very probable that there will be enough free-milling ore found in it to start the mill again. This mine will be a large producer of base ores in the future. "The No. 20 stamp mill has had an experience similar to that of the Musick, and will be a large producer in the future provided systematic development is carried on. The Champion has a tunnel several hundred feet in length, and the free-milling ore exposed in the tunnel was all taken out and run through the mill. The latest news I have from the district is to the effect that they are extending the tunnel into the mountain, and have opened up a shoot of free-milling ore. The Stocks and Harlow property now belonging to the Fairview Mountain Co., has a five-stamp mill. It is the oldest mill in the district. For a few weeks every spring the miners have run the mill on the free-milling ore that has accumulated during the winter months. The ores of the camp principally are base ores, i. e., ores carrying gold, copper and lead.

Work on Summit Smelter. SUMMIT, June 21.—About 20 men were put to work Friday on the site of the 100-ton smelter to be erected here. The first work to be done is to prepare for the burning of 1,000,000 brick to be used on the building. After this the ground will be excavated for the laying of the foundation preparatory to putting in the stone.—Oregon Mining Journal.
