**ANNUAL ASSESSMENT WORK.**  
Although it is pretty generally  
understood that the annual assess-  
ment work required by law to be  
done on unpatented mineral claims,  
should be performed some time,  
within the year succeeding that in  
which the location was made, yet  
this question comes up: If a person  
locates a claim on the first day of  
January, is it necessary that the  
first assessment work should be  
done during that year?  
The answer is: "If a mining  
claim is located on January 1 the  
annual assessment work need not  
be done until within the year com-  
mencing with the succeeding Janu-  
ary or for nearly two years." By  
the act of Congress of January 22,  
1880, section 2324 of the revised  
statutes of the United States was  
amended to read as follows: "Pro-  
vided that the period within which  
the work required to be done an-  
nually on all unpatented mineral  
claims shall commence on the first  
day of January succeeding the date  
of location of such claims and this  
section shall apply to all claims lo-  
cated since the tenth day of May,  
1872."  
So that it matters not whether  
the location is made on the first  
day of January or any other day in  
that month, the year within which  
assessment work should be done  
does not begin until the first day  
of the succeeding January.—Mining  
Review.
