If a single reader of this paper has failed to write letters to some old friend, acquaintance, relative or person who may be benefited by coming to Oregon, he should write today. The colonist rates close Oct. 31st and if you want your letter to get results it must be forwarded at once. The rates are \$25 from Missouri River points, St. Paul, Winnipeg, and all the country adjacent \$30. from St. Louis and \$33 from Chicago, with a reduction of \$2.50 to points east of Umatilla. Similar rates from every other point in the United States. Get busy and add one family to the population of Oregon.

The Oregon Issue, published in Portland, gives a list of all the government permits issued in the dry counties of western Oregon, as shown by the records at the customs house. It says:

"Under a federal law the national government collects a special tax from all persons who deal in alcoholic liquors. Druggists who use liquor in prescription work only are required to pay this tax just the same as the saloon keepers. Our local option law states that the issue of this special tax stamp to any person is selling, exchanging or giving away intoxicating liquor. In the following list are some druggists whom we are very confident are not violating the local option law, and we not wish to direct suspicion toward them. Persons, other than druggists, in this list have no doubt

paid this tax for the express purpose of conducting a criminal traffic in strong drink and some druggists that we know of are also willfully violating the provisions of the law."

Then follows the list, which any one may see:

In Benton county there are only three druggists, at Corvallis.

In Lane county, Cottage Grove has 7, Eugene 17, mostly blind pigs, Junction 4, Springfield 4, Coburg 3, Marcola 1, who has just been fined \$250.

In Linn county, Albany has 13, there being 9 besides drug stores, Brownsville 2, Lebanon 4, Halsey 1, Harrisburg 2, Scio 1.

In Lincoln county, Toledo has 2, Newport 3.

In Tillamook county, Tillamook has 5.

In Yamhill county, McMinnville has 2, Amity, 1, Dayton 1, Sheridan, 2, Willamina 2, Newberg 2, North Yamhill 2, probably all drug stores.

New Bank Formed by Lane Co. Men.

The mills at Springfield, Coburg and Wendling are each operating a day shift, but are shipping very little lumber for the reason that cars are so scarce.—Guard.
