GOT HIM IN JAIL

Klamath Falls, Or., April 10.—The offender of the local option law in Klamath Falls is being severely dealt with, whenever he falls in the clutches of the law. Joe Seed was tried before the justice of the peace here and found guilty of bootlegging.

Seed kept a supply of whiskey in his room at one of the lodging houses and it is claimed made a practice of selling a bottle to some of the thirsty individuals. The judge fined him \$200 and 15 days in jail. The jail sentence is what scares the offenders and it is doing more to stop the traffic than any fine could.

Seed served notice of appeal to the circuit court and the judge placed his bail at \$2000. This was somewhat more than he could raise and he was compelled to go to jail.

Many of the former saloon men have stated that they would be perfectly willing to pay a large fine on conviction, but when they are threatened with a jail sentence they decided that they will not take the chances, the most of them have either left the city or have engaged in other business.

With the present stand taken by officers it is believed that illegal selling of whiskey in Klamath Falls will soon be a thing of the past.
