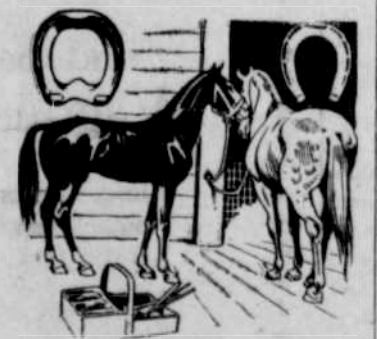

### WHAT WASHINGTON IS DOING FOR POULTRYMEN

The Seattle Poultryman contains the following from the pen of Judge H. H. Collier showing what the state of Washington is doing to assist and encourage its poultry raisers:

The county that cannot hold a poultry show from this on has few if any enterprising poultrymen within its boundaries. At the recent session of the legislature the following bill was passed:

"An act to encourage the exhibiting of poultry, live stock or agricultural products, and to provide funds therefor."

#### THE BILL.

Be it enacted by the legislature of the State of Washington.

Section 1. That any corporation organized for the purpose of holding poultry, live stock or agricultural produce exhibits, may apply to the Board of County Commissioners of such county for a grant to pay expenses and premiums awarded.

Section 2. To enable the said Board of County Commissioners to give said grant, they are hereby authorized to appropriate any sum not exceeding \$250 annually out of the general fund: Provided, that the Board of County Commissioners shall be ex-officio members of such corporation in all counties where appropriations are made under the provisions of this act.

Section 3. The said Board of County Commissioners may not later than July 31, annually, cause to be paid to the directors of said corporation or their duly authorized secretary or treasurer the amount appropriated. Provided, that at least one annual exhibition poultry, live stock or agricultural produce immediately preceding the application for the grant and must provide buildings and other necessary improvements for said annual exhibition."

This bill has been passed and approved by the governor and it becomes a law the first of June. In order to take advantage of the law, each county must have held a show. The quicker each county holds a show and puts itself in line for the appropriation the quicker they get the benefits of the law. Give the counties \$250 and they can pay cash prizes and will not be forced to make the classes fill, but pay cash to every specimen of poultry that can score 90 points.

We now have a county law. What is the matter with going to work and having the next legislature grant each county \$200. With a \$450 purse to start in on, each county could hold a show and pay good prizes. In order for Washington to bring about this result it is up to the poultrymen to pledge their candidates for the legislature to pass the law. It would cost Washington about \$9,000 to give each county two hundred dollars. This is a very small sum but it would do more to encourage the poultry industry than anything that has ever happened. The dairy industry has a commissioner and quite a sum of money is spent each year to further that industry. The poultry industry is of as much importance and if the poultrymen will pull together they can get recognition. One good active man in the legislature from each county would give us a majority and we can get him if we will try. Chicken men make good legislators which was proven by J. C. Hubbel. He was singled out from the whole legislature to be one of five men to investigate the acts of the state officers. We can get a good many poultrymen in the legislature that will make good law-givers and it is up to us to pick them out.

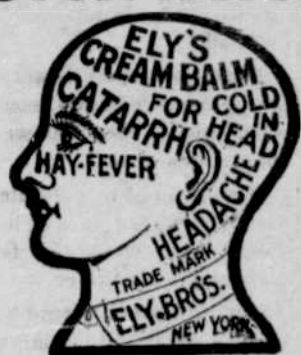

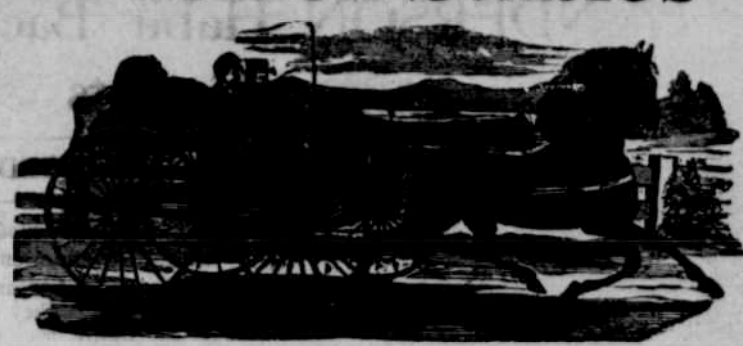
