Disgusted With Alberta.

"Those who go to the Alberta country only do so to come away cursing it, and blaming themselves for their foolishness," was the remark of Mr. Wm. Kohlhaugen this morning. The gentleman arrived in the city from Alberta last evening and is a thoroughly disappointed and disgusted specimen of the genus homo," says the Roseburg News.

A party, of which he was one, left this county for that much advertised country in British Columbia, and their astonishment can be better imagined than described, when arriving in April, they found six inches of snow on the ground and the thermometer standing two degrees below zero. More than this, standing in the fields and poking its head through the snow were the oats and wheat sown the year before, and frozen and entirely ruined while in the bloom in August 1908—not one field, but thousands of acres. This grain, farmers told them, had not thawed once since it was frozen.

In conclusion, Mr. Kohlhaugen declared the persistent advertising of the Alberta region was but a scheme to promote railroad traffic and sell land to gullible purchasers. Anyone going there expecting to find good land and a growing climate will be disappointed. No two seasons are alike, and they are all cold. There are now 1700 people going into that country daily, and 900 coming out. These are facts. It is a Godforsaken country for the farmer or stockraiser.
