The nomination and election of officers—sit up gentlemen and take note—was conducted with fairness and dignity. Mrs. Ada Wallace Unruh, of Portland, was elected in place of Mrs. Henrietta Brown of Albany, a much-loved and honored president. Mrs. Brown feels that her aged mother needs her tender and almost constant care.

Mrs. Ward Swope of Portland, fills the place of corresponding secretary made vacant by Mrs. Unruh's promotion. Mrs. Marsters and Mrs. Shane continue in their old places as recording secretary and treasurer. Mrs. Harford and Mrs. Brown—given minor offices—are retained on the board as advisers.
