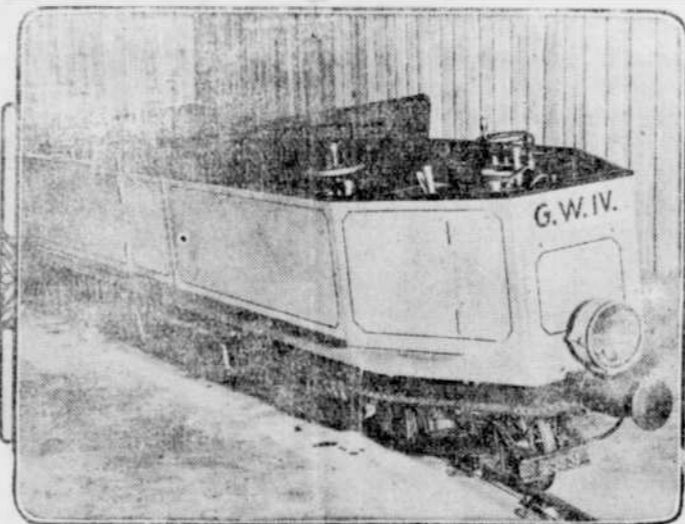

GERMAN GYROSCOPE CAR NOW IN UNITED STATES.

Emil Falcke, Emil Sussermann and a force of ten engineers have arrived in this country, bringing with them the German gyroscope monorail car which August Scherz, proprietor of the daily Berlin newspaper Lokal Anzeiger, has sent to this country for exhibition. The car is not as large as the one used for demonstration by Louis Brennan in England, but the underlying system is the same. It is twenty feet long and four feet wide and is capable of carrying ten persons. The gyroscope revolves at the rate of 8,000 revolutions a minute. It is run by an independent motor. The exhibition car can attain a speed of thirty-five miles an hour.

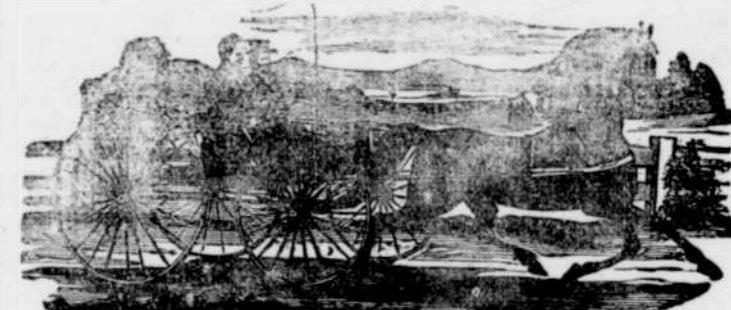
