

gradual increase of the amounts levied for city purposes and that this year you are collecting nine times as much as you did at the beginning of the period, and taking your average city tax for the last five years, which is \$5757, we find that it represents an increase of over 354 per cent over that against the 1904 assessment.

By summary we then find that while the county at large has paid for the past five years an average tax that is 11 2-10 per cent greater than that against the 1904 assessment, Cottage Grove's increase has been only 7 9-10 per cent and that the Cottage Grove school district tax has in like manner been increased to 173 per cent and the city of Cottage Grove has out distanced them all by an increase of over 354 per cent.
