CALL FOR SPECIAL ELECTION.

To all the legal voters of Lane County, State of Oregon, residing within the district, the boundaries of which are defined and described, hereafter in the body of this notice.

Notice is hereby given that by virtue of an initiative petition, duly presented to the Common Council of the City of Cottage Grove, duly signed by 88 legal voters of said District, constituting at least 15% of the legal voters of said district praying for an election and that a special election be called for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the district the boundaries of which said district, are hereinafter described, an act, proposed by said Initiative petition, of which the following in words and figures is a true copy, to-wit:

AN ACT

Extending, enlarging, and defining the corporate limits and boundaries of the City of Cottage Grove, a municipal corporation within Lane County, State of Oregon, providing for the government thereof and adopting a charter therefor.

BE IT ENACTED, by the legal voters of the City of Cottage Grove, residing within the district of Lane County, Oregon, the boundaries of which are described within the body of this act and the legal voters residing within said district, as follows:

Section I. That the City of Cottage Grove, a municipal corporation of Lane County, State of Oregon, incorporated by an act of the special session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon of 1903, which said act was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the 28th day of December, 1903, shall comprise and the boundaries thereof are hereby extended to include all the district of country in the County of Lane, and State of Oregon, contained within the boundaries hereinafter described and shall be a city by the name of Cottage Grove and the people now inhabiting, and those who shall hereafter inhabit, within said district, shall be a municipal corporation by the name of the city of Cottage Grove, and by that name shall sue and be sued, complain and defend in any court, make and use a common seal, and alter it at pleasure; and take, hold and purchase, lease and convey such real, personal or mixed estate as the purpose of the corporation may require within or without the limits aforesaid, and shall be capable of contracting and being contracted with, and shall have the general powers possessed by municipal corporations; and in addition thereto shall possess the powers granted to such corporations under the constitution of the United States and the State of Oregon and the powers hereinafter granted, and the authorities thereof shall have perpetual succession.

Section II. The boundaries of said city as herein extended and enlarged are defined and described as follows, all in Lane county, Oregon to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 33, Tp 20 South, range 3 west, and running thence west to the east line of the W. B. Small D. L. C. No. 62; thence south 12.46 chains to a point 23.15 chains south of the northeast corner of said claim No. 62; thence west 30.50 chains to the Southwest corner of C. E. Stewart's land; thence north 94 links; thence west 20.86 chains to the west line of the W. B. Small D. L. C. No. 62; thence north 11.04 chains to the most westerly northwest corner of said claim No. 62; thence west following the south boundary of the Henry Small D. L. C. No. 57 to a point due south of the Southwest corner of D. G. McFarland's fifth addition to Cottage Grove, Oregon; thence north to the south line of J. W. Gowdy's land at a point on the west line of the corporate limits of Cottage Grove as established by an act of the Legislature on December 22, 1903; thence west to the west line of the Henry Small D. L. C. No. 57; thence north along the west boundaries of D. L. claims No. 57 and 58 to a point 20 chains north of the southwest corner of the James H. McFarland D. L. C. No. 58; thence east to a point 20 chains east of the line between

sections 28 and 29 Tp 20 S. R. 3 West; thence north 20 chains; thence east to the center of the channel of the Coast Fork river; thence following down the center of the channel of said river to the line between lots 5 and 6 plat of the division of the Robt Cochran estate; thence S 61 deg 30' E. between the land deeded to Wm. R. Cochran and the land deeded to John D. Cochran in said division, to a point 15.25 chains west of the east line of the John Cochran D. L. C. No. 55; thence south to a point 28.90 chains north of the south line of said claim No. 55; thence east 7.57 chains; thence south to the south boundary of said John Cochran D. L. C. No. 55 at a point 7.68 chains west of the Southeast corner of said claim No. 55; thence south to the north line of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 34, Tp 20 S. R. 3 W; thence west to the line between Sections 33 and 34, Tp. 20 S. R. 3 W; thence south 40 chains to the place of beginning.

Section III. Except as herein otherwise provided the municipal charter and its amendments thereto, and all ordinances, rules and regulations now in force or which may hereafter be in force, governing the present city of Cottage Grove shall extend to and govern the said city of Cottage Grove within the boundaries thereof as described in Section II of this act.

And by virtue of favorable action taken by said Common Council upon said petition, ordering said election to be held within said district to be held upon Monday the 1st day of May, 1911.

THEREFORE notice is hereby given that an election will be held in said district, the boundaries of which are described in said Act as herein before set out, between the hour of 8 o'clock a. m. and 5 o'clock p. m. on Monday the 1st day of May, 1911; for the approval or rejection of said proposed Act.

THE POLLING PLACES OF SAID ELECTION will be located in the following named places.

One polling place at the Southeast corner of E. 4th and Locust streets, in the first ward within the City of Cottage Grove, Lane county Oregon, and R. M. Veatch shall be judge of said election, and J. C. Wallace and L. A. Ralston, shall be judges and clerks of said election at said polling place.

One polling place at the City Hall in said City of Cottage Grove, in the Council chambers in said hall, and W. H. Blair shall be judge, and J. M. Durham and J. F. Miller shall be judges and clerks of said election at said polling place, which is in the second ward in said city.

One polling place shall be at the Armory, at the Northwest corner of Wall and River streets, in the third ward of said City of Cottage Grove, and J. E. Ostrander shall be judge, and Geo. W. McQueen and C. F. Walker shall be judges and clerks of said election at said polling place.

All legal voters residing within the district, the boundaries of which are defined and described in said proposed act as hereinbefore set out shall be entitled to vote at said election.

All of the legal voters of said district residing within the limits of the city of Cottage Grove, south of Locust street, and all legal voters residing outside of said city limits, within the limits of the district described in said proposed act south of said Locust street, and south of a line extended or in extension east and west of said street shall be entitled to vote at said election at the polling place in said first ward only; all those voters residing in said district between Main street and Locust street in the said city of Cottage Grove, and all those voters residing within said district, within or without said city, between lines in extension east and west of said Main and Locust streets shall be entitled to vote at the polling place in said second ward only; all legal voters residing in said district, north of Main and Wall streets, of said city, and north of lines west in extension of Wall street and east in extension of Main street shall be entitled to vote at the polling place in said third ward only.
