Washington, Oct. 5.—Each citizen of the United States, under an equal division, would have \$34.35, the per capita circulation on October 2, according to the circulation statement of the Treasury Department. The total money in circulation amounted to \$3,242,182,715, an increase over the preceding month, when it was \$3,228,913,634. On October 1, 1910, the money in circulation totaled \$3,164,827,281.

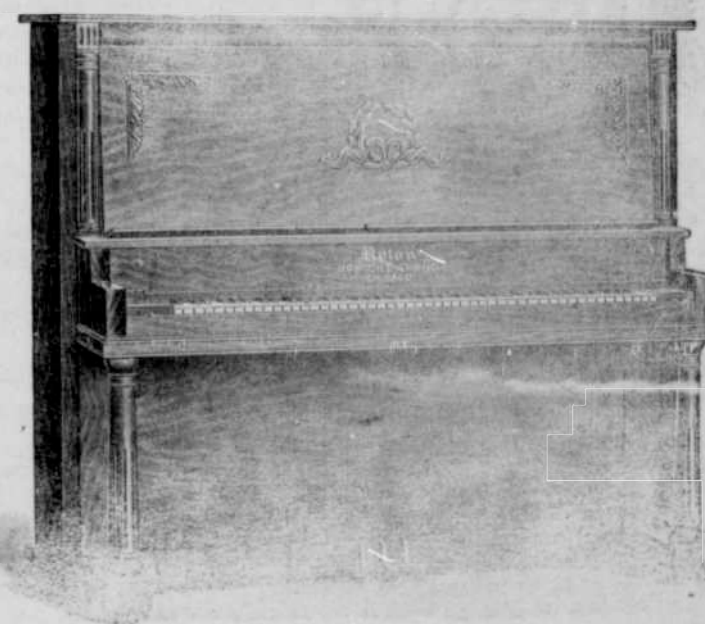
