SENATOR GORE ON CIVIC DUTIES

A small but very appreciative audience greeted Senator Thomas P. Gore at Villard Hall last evening and listened for two hours to a most eloquent address on social and civic duties, and political questions of the day. Dr. Joseph Schafer, in a few, well chosen words, introduced the speaker.

Senator Gore won his audience at once by the beautiful tribute he paid to Eugene, calling her the "Athens" of the great state of Oregon and saying that he wished for her everything on earth she wanted from a football team "up and down."

He said: "We can raise the standard of our citizenship only by improvement of the individual; the individual is the unit of society and by improving this unit we improve the whole; in this way and this alone can we improve the whole of society."

He also spoke on the tariff question, on government, both city and national. In speaking of the appropriations made by congress for different purposes, he said:

"Let us cultivate that patriotism that lives for one's country rather than the patriotism that dies for one's country. Let us spend more money in building homes and for agricultural purposes, and less for equipping war vessels. In other words let us spend more money teaching men how to live rather than sending our neighbor to an early grave."

The senator made but brief reference to politics and that when he said:

"There are a few bad democrats, 'just a few'; there are some good republicans, 'just a few.'—Eugene Register.

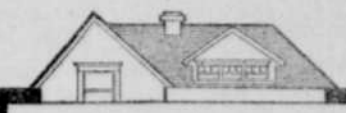

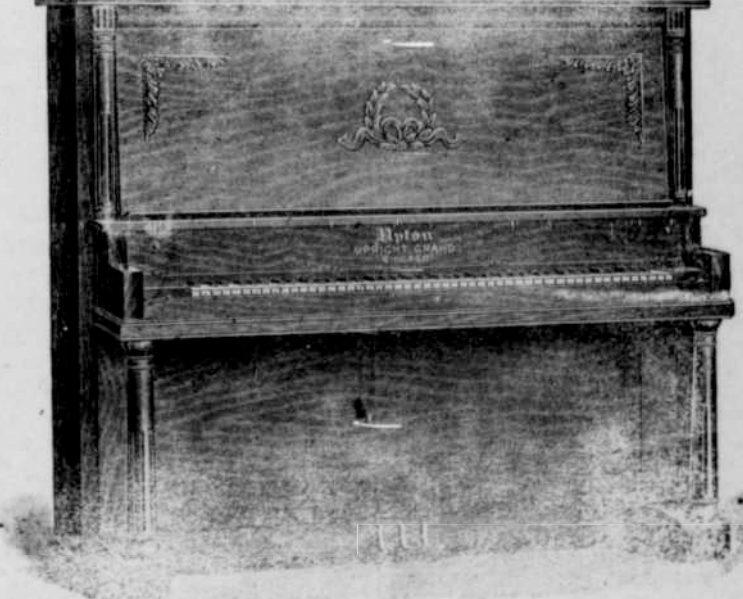
