150 LIVES LOST WHEN SHIPS ARE TORPEDOED

Two British Steamers Victims of Powerful German Submarines. London.—About 150 lives were lost in the sinking by German submarines of the African liner Falaba and the British steamer Agulla, bound from Liverpool for Lisbon.
