Pipe Line to Cemetery.

It is only one week since the City Council authorized the use of city water in the Masonic and Odd Fellow Cemetery, yet through the energetic effort of citizens the pipe line has been laid and water is now available in the beautiful hillside cemetery, and without cost to the city. Expense of installation was borne entirely to the public spirited citizens. Work was begun almost immediately after permission was secured from the Council and on Tuesday last water was turned on in the pipes. Heretofore those who desired to improve lots in the cemetery were prevented from doing so by the impossibility of getting water to use for irrigation. The use of the water will be only during the summer season and it is expected by the Council that no waste will be permitted.
