ARE RUSHING WORK

Mayflower Mining Company Developing Property in Bohemia District.

Mayflower Mining Company is pushing development work on its properties in the Bohemia district, and the members of the company have every confidence that it will ultimately prove to be one of the best paying mines in that camp. W. P. Ely, of Kelso, Wash., is in Portland today, and the other principal holders of stock are John A. Beck and Mr. Carlson, of Portland.

For a number of years the company has been doing development work on its group of claims, and it has been rewarded by opening up ores of promising values. It has been rumored that the company intended soon to put a stamp mill on the property, but the management disclaims such intention until more ore is blocked out.

L. N. Roney, of Eugene, excellent commander of the Oregon Commandery Knights Templar, arrived in Portland this morning, and will go to Baker City tonight to institute a new commandery. He will be accompanied by a party of Portland Knights Templar. The Millionaire mine, of the Gold Hill district, a property in which Portland people are interested, is making a splendid showing with development. Both day and night shifts are employed, and two shifts are being driven on the two ledges. A steam hoist is used to facilitate development work. The operating company intends to have the Millionaire sufficiently opened up and developed by next Spring to install a 10-stamp mill.—Telegram.

A Portland Smelter...Why Not?

Will Oregon become a smelting center? Strange things have happened. In the year just closing, a step has been taken in that direction at a time and place pronounced impracticable. Sumpter's little plant has surprised confident observers by stimulating a production of smelting ore believed impossible. When a company of promoters announced their purpose of erecting a modern smelter in Baker county, most of the mining men of the district to be benefited laughed at the assumption, and were so cold in their attitude as to positively wet-blanket the enterprise. When a plant was completed, after the outlay of about \$200,000 by eastern men otherwise not interested in the district, the idle smelter was indicated with a measure of gratification by the pessimists as a monument to their own good judgment, and the surpassing folly of its projectors. Instead of hastening to cooperate with the management of the reduction plant, its future was a matter of such indifference that the initiative for permanent work had to be taken by outside people again.

But now the Sumpter smelter has assurance of being a permanent success. It is proving that the small quantity of coke required for the charge in the semi-pyritic process is more easily hauled in than the much larger proportion of ore in that charge may be hauled out. Metallurgical losses, held by some

of the most prominent experts to be prohibitive in a district receiving no greater variety of ore than was tributary to Sumpter, have not proven so in practice. The stimulation given production so far has increased the available tonnage from about 5,000 tons per year shipped before, to enough to supply a 100-ton furnace running full time.

Even prudent men become too conservative sometimes. With such an example of what may be done in fire reduction, Portland has a powerful incentive to realize the fond dream of years. Portland is admirably situated for a smelter. Alaska's large number of quartz mines along the coast will increase the tonnage of concentrates from the north country in wonderful measure. Big mills are being erected there each year. The Coeur d'Alenes could deliver ore and concentrates here far more cheaply than at Everett, and the possible cost of this haul will be further reduced by an open river. St. Helens district is nearer Portland than any other prominent center, and is already offering copper ore for smelting. Bohemia is destined to furnish a good tonnage of concentrates. Southern Oregon is demonstrating in the first good mining done there that ore and concentrates will be offered smelters. Both ocean steamers and railways on a water-grade haul can deliver ore to Portland. If someone with the same grit demonstrated at Sumpter will break the ice, he is sure of building up a heavy business at Portland.

Will Amend Liquor Law.

Amendment of the local option law to the extent of providing that hereafter all liquor elections shall be held on the precinct basis will likely be effected at the next session of the Oregon Legislature. On every hand is heard a demand for legislation of this kind, and an amendment will be undertaken by a bill to that effect. Reliable information has it that if such an amending bill is introduced it will become part of the local option law.

There is even heard a rumor that an effort may be made to repeal the law, but now that the act is a decree of the people it is not regarded as probable that the Legislature will take it upon itself to set it aside, but rather to amend it into a local option act, and give the people that for which they thought they were voting when the law was carried at the polls. The fact that many regarded the measure as a purely precinct option act and woke up to find that it was after all a prohibition law, when their votes had been cast, would, so many of the Legislators think justify them in amending the law as the peoples' representatives, to conform to that which it was originally believed to be.

Members of the Multnomah delegation say they have heard much discussion regarding an amendment since the election, and it comes from a pretty authoritative source that a bill will be introduced and that it will come from Multnomah County.
