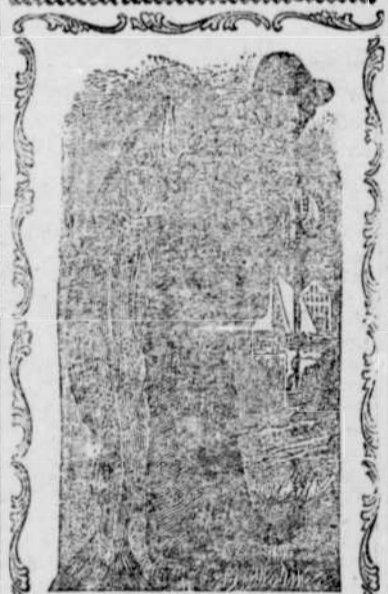

## McQueen and Hemenway Flop

No Election of United States Senator yet Corbett gains two votes.

State University fares well—Another large appropriation made for a new heating plant.

SALEM, Feby 20—The ballot for United States Senator to day shows again of two votes for Corbett. The floppers were McQueen and Hemenway, of Lane County, who have been considered among Hermans strongest supporters up to the present time.

Vote stood; Corbett, 34; Hermann, 27; Inman 26, Williams 2, Bennett 1. The house passed an appropriation bill carrying \$25000 for construction of central light, water and heating plant and power house for the State University.

This makes a total appropriation for the U of O, for the year, of Seventy thousand dollars. Verily Lane County has received her share at the hands of the Legislature.

It is not believed Corbett will make further inroads into Lane County's delegation. It is true no body expected McQueen to go over to him, but knowing ones in this end of the county have prophesied Hemenway would sooner or later go for the old "man of the sea."

The Senate and House have adopted a joint resolution fixing the date of adjournment at midnight Saturday, Feb. 23.

The sensation is the report of the committee to investigate the affairs of the State Land department. It charges a defalcation of \$30,000 by Geo W Davis late clerk of the State board under Governor Penoyer.

Salem Daily Sentinel:—There has been some talk about the insincerity of Senator McBride's friends voting for Mr Hermann. After today's ballot we should hear no more of it. Some of the original Hermann men, however, appear to have been troubled with insincerity, or something equally discreditable.

The Postoffice department is preparing new mail contracts on star routes so as to include a provision whereby persons living along such routes may have their mail deposited in boxes to be erected by them. A general advertisement inviting proposals for carrying the mail on all star and steamboat mail routes in Oregon for a term of four years beginning July 1, 1902, will be issued September next. It is the intention of the department to incorporate in all contracts entered into for service under this advertisement a provision where by the persons living along the line of the route may if they so desire to have their mail deposited in boxes erected by them for such purpose except on routes where the requirements of such box delivery service would be impracticable, of which due report should be made, giving explicitly the reasons why such service is considered impracticable.

PRETORIA, Feb. 20.—An Attempt was made to wreck the train on which Lord Kitchener was traveling. The train was proceeding to the commando at Klip river when it was blown up by a mine placed on the rails.

PRETORIA, Feb. 20.—The Boers derailed the train carrying General Kitchener's baggage. They were driven off after having secured the contents of the train.

LONDON Feb 20.—No news comes from the English columns under Smith Dorrien and it is believed they are lost in South Africa.

NEW YORK, Feb 20.—The Chinese government has announced that it will endeavor to float a two hundred million dollar loan in the United States in order to meet the expense of the late war.

### Spain Financially Ruined.

MADRID, Feb. 18.—Ex Premier Silveira said today the disorders in Spain are the outcome of the late war with the United States. Spain, he declares, was financially ruined by that contest.

ORAMA, Feb. 20.—Information from direct sources, obtained by the World-Herald, indicates that the Sioux Indians are seriously contemplating an uprising, if demands now being formulated for submission to Washington are not complied with. Several council meetings have already been held, particularly among the Ogallala Sioux, and preparations are now being made for a great council to select delegates to Washington. Owing to the desire to the desire to avoid sensationalism, the gatherings of the small councils have been given little notice, but the aspect is now considered grave.
