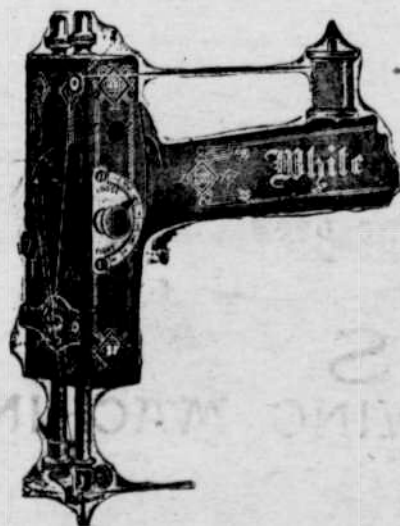

Boer Cause Waning

Events of An Unlucky Friday.

PORT ELIZABETH, Cape Colony Feb. 27.—A private message received here says Scheiper's Laager, near Willowmoore, has been captured by the British. The main body of the Boers was absent. About 40 burghers and the whole of the supplies were taken.

DEAR Cape Colony, Feb. 26.—Thornycroft's column, when, last heard from, was a few hours' march behind Dewet. The other columns have seemingly lost touch with him. Hertzog, the Boer commander, is reported to have crossed the Orange River, and appears to be still inside the rectangle formed by the railroads and the river.

The Golden Gate Horror.

The steamer Rio Jenero, arriving direct from the Orient, struck a rock outside the Golden Gate at San Francisco, last Friday morning, and sank within twenty minutes. Many of the passengers went down with the ship, sleeping in their berths.

U S Consul Wildman and family, were among the lost. He and his wife and two children were on their way home from Hong Kong, China. Captain Ward, seeing the fate of his ship, is said to have locked himself in his stateroom and went down with it. There were on board the Rio Janiero 29 cabin passengers, 150 in the steerage and 140 in the crew. 128 persons in all were lost. A dense fog was prevailing at the time to which is attributed the terrible catastrophe.

Dewet Makes Ugly Charges.

General Dewet has issued a proclamation, in Cape Colony, declaring that the British have ignored and disregarded the rules of civilized warfare. He accuses the English of capturing doctors and ambulances and deporting them in order to deprive the wounded Boers of medical assistance, and charges them with the arming of Kaffirs to be employed against the Boers.

Ugly charges have been made regarding the treatment of Boer women and children by the British. Old mothers and women have been ravished and that even the wives and children and the property of prisoners of war and dead burghers have not been respected. In many instances both mother and father have been taken, the house left unprotected and all left to their fate, an easy prey to savages.

ST PAUL, Minn., Feb. 26.—The number of today's westbound homeseekers is about the same as a week ago. Additional coaches were attached to the regular trains to the limit of the hauling capacity of the locomotives. On the "Soo" line there were a large number of passengers for North Dakota. Perhaps in all the Great Northern and Northern Pacific carried out 400 homeseekers for Washington and Oregon. Tomorrow's trains, however, will be as large, if not larger, than those of a week ago. The general passenger agents of each road have ordered one extra train. Reports received by them indicate that there will be a great rush tomorrow. The traffic is about equally divided. All will go through to Washington. Three car loads of today's passengers came from Iowa.

LONDON Feb. 27.—General Kitchener is making a very vigorous campaign against the Boers under Generals Dewet and Botha. Their commands are badly scattered.

NEW YORK, Feb. 27.—General Sikes, Grand Commander of the Grand Army of the Republic, declares that the organization will not parade at the inauguration of President McKinley, Monday, March 4th.

COLFAX, Wash., Feb. 25.—Mrs. Rosa Wurzer, a widow, in a fit of insanity drowned her six children, aged from 1 to 12 years at Uniontown, Wash., Sunday. Two were boys and four girls. She threw them into a well 30 feet deep containing two feet of water, then jumped in herself and held the heads of the children beneath the surface until all were drowned.
