## Trapped at Last

AGUINALDO A PRISONER IN AMERICAN HANDS.

He is now in a Manila Jail.

Nebraska Deadlock, and other news.

MANILA, March 28.—General Frederick Funston's daring project for the capture of Aguinaldo in his hiding place in the Province of Isabela, Island of Luzon, has proved completely successful. Aguinaldo was captured there on March 23.

The U S gunboat Vicksburg, Commander F B Barry, with Gen. Funston and Aguinaldo on board, arrived here this morning.

Aguinaldo was brought ashore at 3:10 p m today and taken before General MacArthur at the Malacanang Palace. He talked freely, but seemed ignorant concerning recent events. He appeared to be in good health and was even cheerful. He lunched with the officers of General MacArthur's staff and was then escorted to the Enda-street jail.

Aguinaldo's capture was attended with considerable difficulty, an insurgent Major being killed at the time of the event. Twenty rifles and a number of important papers were captured.

LONDON, March 28.—A dispatch from Manila says that several members of Aguinaldo's staff were captured with him and brought to Manila. The insurgent leader and his men were captured near Casiguran, north of Brier.

LONDON, March 27.—Advices from Constantinople are to effect that affairs are rapidly reaching a dangerous pass there, Turkish finances are in inextricable confusion. Upward of a million Turkish pounds are due for war material while military expenditures are daily increasing.

The superintendent of the Du-buque division of the Chicago Great Western Railroad Company has issued a sweeping order to employes which has caused a sensation. In effect, it prohibits them from using intoxicating liquor in any form or at any time.

It applies to trainmen, station agents, foremen and other who hold responsible positions with the company. It prohibits them from entering saloons or using liquor whether on or off duty, and the penalty for any violation of this rule is immediate discharge of the offender.

The order also commands all employes to pay their honest debts, and any failure to do so will cause their immediate discharge unless a responsible excuse can be given.
