BUFFALO N. Y. May 1.—Fifteen
hundred machinists in this city and
Erie county struck today to secure
a nine-hour day without decrease of
pay. It is understood that the
movement is a forerunner of a strike
that may extend all over the United
States, Canada and Mexico.
