**THE FIELD MEET**--About 1000 people attended the field meet between the U of O and U of C track teams last Monday at Bang's Park. Of course the U of C won, but Oregon's showing was better than Stanfords against the same team a week ago. She Oregon boys scored a total of 42 points out of a possible 117, winning the 120 yard hurdle and discus throw, tied them on the pole vault. And took second place in the 700 yard dash, 220 yard hurdle, broad jump, shot put, and hammer throw, the score follows:

100 yard dash--won by Cadogan, U C; Heater, U O, 2nd; Hussey, 3rd. Time 10 sec.

High jump--won by Cooley, U C. Distance 2ft, 9 3/4 in.

Discus throw--won by Wagner; Tout, 2nd; Smith, 3rd; all of U O. Distance 99 ft, 6 in.

Broad jump--won by Hussey, U C; Heater, U O, 2nd; Cheek, U C, 3rd. Distance, 22 ft, 5 1/2 in.

Under the new mining law recently passed by the Oregon Legislature the procedure in locating mining claims (either lode or placer) is as follows: First, posting discovery notice--which shall give the general direction, and approximate size of the claim; second, marking the boundaries by six posts or monuments, each at least four inches square and projecting three feet above the surface, one at each corner, and one at the center of each end line; third, discovery work, and fourth, recording.
