## Drowned at Latham

Guy Lee and Martin Tucker, while Bathing, Drowned before the eyes of their helpless Comrades

A number of Men and Boys on the Scene soon after failed in their Search for the bodies until too late to bring them to life.

Tuesday evening, Guy Lee, son of Bert Lee and Martin Tucker son W W Tucker, aged respectively 17 and 13 years, were drowned just above Latham while in bathing. The boys had been down to this city late in the evening and had started home and stopped at the river for a swim. They were accompanied by two other boys Reuben Tucker an older brother of Martin and the little son of Mr Will Coffin, at Divide. None of the boys could swim to amount to anything and the lamentable accident from best accounts occurred as follows. The Coffin boy who could not swim at all had gone out and the other three had hold of each others hands and were wading down the stream, when they came to a jump off suddenly and all went in over their depth, owing to the darkness and their fright all became straggled and Reuben Tucker after considerable struggle was able to get out but Guy Lee and Martin Tucker grasped each other and soon sank from view. Mr Coffin's boy set up a yell at once and in a few minutes a number of men were on hand, but only one or two of the number were able to swim. Mr Adams made a few efforts by diving and with assistance the body of Guy Lee was found about three hours later. Every means known to those present was resorted to in efforts to revive Guy but without avail and the heart broken father who was soon at the scene was compelled to give his boy up and take him home to a sorrowing mother. Efforts to find Martin was continued throughout the night and Mr Coffin was finally successful in locating the body in about 5 feet of water a few yards below, just at daybreak. It is lamentable that among the crowd soon gathered no good swimmers could be found, for the water was but little over six or seven feet deep at any place where the boys were drowned and could timely assistance have been rendered these two bright youths might have been saved. Owing to the hot weather it was deemed best to bury them Wednesday afternoon and they were accordingly brought down to the Grove at 4 o'clock and the funeral services were held at the M E Church in the presence of a large congregation, Elder Babcock officiating, and at five o'clock the remains of the unfortunate lads were buried in the Masonic Cemetery.

The sympathy of the entire community goes out to the bereaved parents and families in their sudden affliction.
