Fred Bean, of Mapleton, is in Eugene on a business trip. He informs us that the Lower Siuslaw country was just entering on a great timber boom when the San Francisco strike was announced. The sawmills were running full time, and many logging camps were starting up. About 1,000,000 feet of lumber every two weeks was shipped by a fleet of schooners to the San Francisco markets. Word first came that the vessels were tied up. Mill companies thinking the trouble was only temporary continued sawing until every portion of the docks and yards were full to overflowing, and Saturday night all the mills shut down indefinitely or at least until the strike is over in the city. Orders have also been sent to the logging camps to shut down and discharge everybody. This makes the people on the river feel blue.—Guard.

Crop Bulletin.

The past week has been dry, except during Wednesday, local showers occurred in the southern and eastern sections of the State. These rains were very beneficial to the rye and to the root crops but they were not general enough to wholly relieve the droughty conditions prevailing in that section, and more rain is needed in all parts of the State for late crops.

The week on a whole was slightly cooler than the previous one, and generally favorable for the ripening of grain and fruit. Threshing is now in active progress in all parts of the State and the yields are generally turning out better than expected. Those reported this week are about the same as last week.

Hops are a little backward, but the crop promises to be an average one in quantity and above the average in quality. The lice are doing no damage and the only complaint made is that the soil is too dry for rapid growth. The potato crop is being shortened by drouth, but no injury has so far occurred through insect pests, and with good rains in the near future the potato crop will be nearly an average one. Corn shows slight improvement but it is still backward. Range grass is getting poor and stock continues to lose in flesh. Fruit of all kinds is making good advancement, except that in Marion and Benton counties the Italian prunes are reported to be dropping more than usual. Apples are doing nicely.

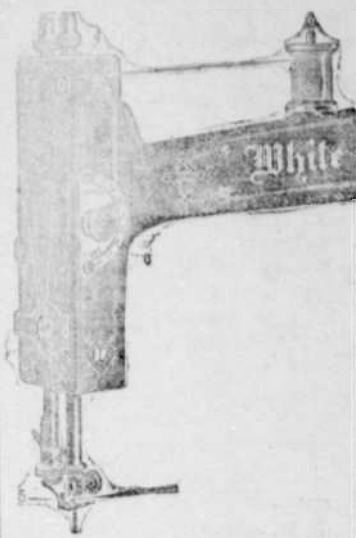
