France and Turkey Sever Diplomatic Relations.

CONSTANTINOPLE —Aug 21—The
French Ambassador, L Canstan, has
notified the sultan's first secretary
that all diplomatic relations between
France and Turkey are broken off
and that the Ambassador has in-
formed his Government to this effect.
Constan communicated direct with
the Sultan because the latest negoti-
ations were transacted with the Sul-
tan personally. The Ambassador
justifies his action on the ground
that the Sultan broke his direct,
personal promise, given to M Con-
stans at an audience in the Yildiz
Palace Thursday regarding the
purchase of the disputed French
claims. The Foreign Minister also
gave formal assurances that the
agreement would be carried out, so
in view of this breach of faith. M.
Constans holds that it is impossible
for France to continue diplomatic
relations with Turkey.

MARTINEZ, Cal, Aug 21.—Jack
Winters, the man who got away with
\$330,000 in gold bullions from the
Selby Smelting Works, and after-
wards confessed, was sentenced
today to 15 years at Folsom. The
prisoner took the sentence coolly,
and ask that he be sent to San-
Quentin, but the request was re-
fused.

The prisoner was taken to Folsom
this morning, and before night will
be in stripes.

It's all very well for the Govern-
ment to declare that it cannot con-
vict Neeley because it cannot compel
witnesses to go to Havana. The
fact is that outside witnesses would
merely lend corroborative detail; the
real evidence against him is in the
Havan: Post Office records. How-
ever, the Government doesn't
intend to convict Neeley. He stands
too close to some other thieves in
Washington.

What presumption it is for the
Knights of Labor to try to compel
Attorney General Knox to execute
his sworn duty and prosecute the
Steel Trust! Do not the Knights
know that Mr Knox drew the ar-
ticles under which the Steel Trust was
incorporated and that he was chosen
for his present post by the influence
of the Steel Trust? How can they
ask him to prove treacherous to it.

An effort is to be made to remove
a large red oak tree from the wildest
section of Arkansas to Forest Park,
St Louis, for Louisiana Purchase
Exposition. The tree is 160 feet
high and 12 feet in diameter at the
base. A double tramway will be
built from the tree to the river where
it will be floated and towed to St

According to revised computations
on the production of gold and silver
throughout the world during the
year 1900 there were mined \$255,-
924,654 of gold and \$112,205,732 of
silver. The United States leads the
production of both these metals,
having produced during the year
1900 \$79,159,674 of gold and \$36,-
556,900 of silver. Australasia ranks
second in the production of gold,
her output being \$73,467,110, and
Mexico ranks second in the produc-
tion of silver, her product for last
year being \$34,269,494.
