President McKinley is Dead.

MILBURN HOUSE, BUFFALO, Sept. 14.—President McKinley died at 2:15 A M He had been unconscious most of the time since 7:50 P M. His last conscious hour on earth was spent with the wife to whom he devoted a life time of care. He died unattended by a minister of the gospel, but his last words were a humble submission to the will of the God in whom he believed.

THE CAUSE OF DEATH.

BUFFALO, Sept. 14.—The following report of the autopsy upon the remains of President McKinley was issued at 5 o'clock.

"The bullet which struck over the breastbone did not pass through the skin and did little harm. The other bullet passed through both walls of the stomach near its lower border. Both holes were found to be perfectly closed by the stitches, but the tissue around each hole had become gangrenous. After passing through the stomach the bullet passed into the back walls of the abdomen, hitting and tearing the upper end of the kidney. This portion of the bullet's track was also gangrenous, involving the pancreas. The bullet has not yet been found. There was no sign of peritonitis or disease of other organs. The heart walls were very thin. There was no evidence of an attempt at repair on the part of nature, and death resulted from the gangrene which affected the stomach around the bullet wounds, as well as the tissues around the further course of the bullet. Death was unavoidable by any surgical or medical treatment, and was the direct result of the bullet wound."

BUFFALO, Sept. 14.—Theodore Roosevelt took the oath of office as President of the United States at the residence of Ansley Wilcox at 3:32 o'clock this afternoon. The oath was administered by United States Judge, John S. Hazel.

In taking the oath the president said: "In this hour of deep and national bereavement, I wish to state that it shall be my aim to continue absolutely and without variance the policy of president McKinley for the peace and prosperity and honor of our beloved country."

However the belief is expressed that there will be a complete change of the cabinet under Pres. Roosevelt; not immediately, of course, but probably by December 1st. This belief is based on the wellknown fact that neither the late president nor the members of the cabinet or immediate advisers and friends were particularly friendly with Mr. Roosevelt. The nomination of Roosevelt as vice president was accepted as a matter of necessity, rather than choice, and the closest friends of McKinley breathed a prayer at that time that nothing might happen to McKinley. While the impression of a complete change prevails, it might not occur.
