EXTRACTS FROM ROOSEVELT'S MESSAGE TO CONGRESS.

The personal equation is the most important factor in abusiness operation.

Prosperity can never be created by law alone, though it is easy enough to destroy it by mischievous laws.

If ever anarchy is triumphant, its triumph will last but for one red moment, to be succeeded for ages by the gloomy night of despotism.

The welfare of each citizen, and therefore the welfare of the aggregate of citizens which makes the Nation, must rest upon individual thrift and energy, resolution and intelligence.

The reclamation and settlement of the arid lands will enrich every portion of our country, just as the settlement of the Ohio and Mississippi Valleys brought prosperity to the Atlantic States.

Is it not true that as the rich have grown richer and the poor have grown poorer. On the contrary never before has the average man, the wage-worker, the farmer, the small trader, been so well off as in this country and at the present time.

Disaster to great business enterprises can never have its effect limited to the men at the top. It spreads throughout, and while it is bad for everybody, it is worst for those farthest down. The capitalist may be shorn of his luxuries; but the wageworker may be deprived of even bare necessities.

The preservation of our forests is an imperative business necessity.

The peoples of the Americas can prosper best if left to work out their own salvation in their own way.

Combination and concentration should be not prohibited, but supervised and within reasonable limits controlled.

We desire the peace which comes as of right to the just man armed; not the peace granted on terms of ignominy the craven and the weakling.

The forest reserves should be set apart forever for the use and benefit of our people as a whole, and not sacrificed to the short-sighted greed of a few.

The effort should be steadily to make the Indian work like any other man on his own ground. The marriage laws of the Indian should be made the same as those of the whites.

The American people must either build and maintain an adequate Navy or else make up their minds definitely to accept a secondary position in international affairs not merely in political but in commercial matters.

No single great material work which remains to be undertaken on this continent is of such consequence to the American people as the building of a canal across the Isthmus connecting North and South America.

The individual American enlisted man is probably on the whole a more formidable fighting man than regular of any other Army. Every consideration should be shown him and in return the highest standard of usefulness should be exacted from him.
