

LIVE WEIGHT OF CATTLE.

To be able to tell the live weight of cattle would often be of considerable value to both buyer and seller. Here is a rule which will be found to be quite reliable. Measure the girth around the breast, just behind the shoulder blade, and the length of the back from the tail to the forepart of the shoulder blade and multiply the girth by length. If the girth is less than three feet multiply the product obtained by eleven and the result will be the number of pounds. If girth is between three and five feet, multiply by sixteen; if between five and seven feet multiply by twenty-three; if between seven and nine feet, multiply by thirty-one; if between nine and eleven feet, multiply by forty. It will, of course, require a little practice to be able to tell the weight correctly, even with the use of this rule.

QUARTERS FOR SWINE.

We have read many discussions comparing the advantage of using small movable houses for hogs with the plan of having a larger building for the accommodation of all of them. As a rule it will be found that both are necessary. In the fattening of hogs, or even the management of brood sows, there are conditions under which it is best to have them in permanent quarters. This is especially true in the instance of feeding hogs, for it is quite a task to carry the feed from one small house to another, especially if the ground is soft and muddy or covered with deep snow. There is much economy of labor in the feeding by having a large single hog house holding all the hogs. The feed must be sorted in such a building, and the giving of it to the hogs may be done with little labor. In such a building it is of material advantage to have a feeding floor distinct from the feeding quarters, and then a yard in conjunction with this. Where the hogs are not following cattle this arrangement is very satisfactory, requiring only the additional improvement of having a single apartment in which to put the sows at farrowing time. This should be separated from the rest of the quarters, warm, and especially provided with a strip around the wall six inches above the floor and projecting about eight. This is quite effective in protecting the young pigs, for very frequently the sows when lying down next to the wall will lie on them unless there is something of this kind under which the little pigs may protect themselves. The advantage of having small and movable houses is that the sow is completely alone, and then again, the hogs may be changed from one lot to another. This is of material advantage in the summer when a change of lot is desirable for the purpose of securing fresh pasture. The movable houses are especially useful in summer, but are rather unsatisfactory during the winter season. All things considered, it is best for the hog raiser to be equipped with buildings of both kinds. If possessed of a permanent hog house it will pay the swine breeder to plan some of the small movable houses and build them this winter while there is time available, for some houses of this kind are very useful in the summer management of swine.—Iowa Homestead.
