

ABOUT DIPPING SHEEP.

"The bureau of animal industry of the department of agriculture is seriously considering a revision of its regulations for dipping sheep intended for transmission from one state to another.

"It may be first recalled," stated Dr. Salmon, chief of the bureau "that, owing to certain practical trade conditions the bureau has thus far insisted upon a single dipping, instead of on two dipping two days apart. Notwithstanding this concession which has thus far been made to trade conditions, we have noticed that of 15,112 sheep dipped 80 percent were effected by one dip and only 14 per cent ineffective. It must be confessed that this is a better result on single dip than ever we hoped to obtain, since the treatment had to be performed at so many different places, hence by different states of man, on which account absolute uniformity could hardly be expected. The 14 per cent of ineffective cases clearly indicate, however, that the period must soon come to an end during which the bureau can make a temporary concession to traders in order that they may adapt themselves to conditions which they must clearly foresee. While many buyers and shippers have cheerfully co-operated with the bureau in its work of restricting scab, this can not be said of all of them. Those dealers and feeders who who endeavor to eradicate the disease are now shown to be subject to certain amount of risk or failure or re-infection due 14 per cent of failure from a single dipping. It is therefore only a question of a short time when the bureau will find it absolutely necessary in protecting sheep raisers and feeders to insist upon a double dipping. Sheep raisers would do well to take this warning seriously, and to doubt their efforts for the eradication of the disease not only from their own flocks, but from the other flocks in their country. To allow scab to exist in a neighbor's flock, when he is careless as to ignore the warnings given, is for the cautious sheep-raiser to assume a risk of having his own sheep held for a double dipping in case they come into contact with his neighbors sheep during shipment."

MILK ABSORBS ODORS.

You cannot feed mouldy hay, bad silage, musty corn fodder that has been put into the mow when it was not in shape to go there, and get good milk. The use of any such materials will get you into trouble and will of itself prevent you from making high grade milk. No feed that has an odor should be permitted to remain about the stables. You may set a vessel filled with milk in a silo for an hour; then if you take it out and heat it, you can tell by the nose it has been in the silo. At the Vermont station we could heat the milk up to 110 degrees and by the smell tell whether it had been near a hog pen or not.

Milk should be aerated for two purposes: 1st, to retain its sweetness 2d, to remove odors foreign to it. The principal of aeration is to expose as much of the milk to the air as possible by allowing it to pass in very thin sheets or streams over a cool surface. There have been various devices manufactured for this purpose, some of them were quite expensive, but today there are several makes which do the work very satisfactorily and are so cheap that no one should be without one. Anyone not wishing to purchase an aera or can use a long handled dipper with which the milk can be stirred and poured from one can to another, holding the dipper high above the can so as to allow the milk to pass through the air on being poured from it.
