THE NEW TAX LAW.

At the last session of the legislature a new law was passed in regard to the collection of taxes, which law took effect on December 1st, 1901, and in substance is as follows:

1 If you pay your taxes on or before March 15 you will be allowed a rebate of 3 per cent.

2 If you pay your taxes between March 15th and up to and including the first Monday in April, there will not be any rebate and neither will there be any penalty, or interest added.

3 If your taxes are not paid on or before the first Monday of April, they will become delinquent of 10 per cent and the tax will also draw interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum in addition to the penalty.

4 If you pay one half of your taxes on or before the first Monday in April, then the remaining half may run up to and including the first Monday in October following; but if the last half of tax due is not paid by the first Monday of October it became delinquent, and there will be added to such balance, a penalty of 10 per cent, and in addition, such balance will bear interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum from the first Monday in April until paid.

5 On all personal property taxes, if one-half is not paid on or before the first Monday in April, the law compels the sheriff to levy upon and collect the same after May 1st, hence to prevent a levy upon personal property after May 1st, it will be necessary for one half to be paid as above stated.

6 The law compels the sheriff to sell all lands on which taxes have not been paid, and that such sales shall not be held later than March 1st of the year succeeding the year in which the tax levy is made.

7 The property will be sold to the person bidding the lowest rate of interest, and certificates will be issued therefor, and deeds given to such property sold unless redeemed within three years from the date of such sale.

Mines and Mining.

The Cascade Coal Mining Co is making rapid preparations for extensively operating the Wilhelm coal mine near Creswell.

A large amount of machinery has arrived on the ground and the boiler and pump have been placed in position ready to pump the water out of the shaft so that the work will be facilitated.

A force of men are now employed at the mine and more will be added as work progresses.

The members of the company are all enthusiastic over the prospects for a rich body of coal to be uncovered.

They have two veins of coal in their mines, each being over eight feet thick.

George W Lloyd, of Cottage Grove president of the Crystal Consolidated Mining Company was a visitor at the Oregon Mining Exchange this morning, having just returned from Boston, where he spent several months, says the Portland Telegram.

"Eastern people are beginning to think well of Oregon mines as an investment," said Mr Lloyd this morning, "especially as they realize that most of the mines in this state are tunneling propositions. They are afraid of sinking properties, both by reason of the expense of mining and overcoming the water difficulty. There are mines in Colorado that spent \$1,000,000 pumping water alone. Gold mines are in strongest demand. This is due to the fact that gold values no longer fluctuate. Gold is not looked upon as a commodity of fluctuating value as is copper, silver or other metals. I look for large Eastern investments in Oregon mines during the next few years, and believe I am safe in the prediction that in ten years Oregon will be ahead of Colorado as a mining state."

Editor Woolley who has spent the past three months in the Scott's Valley mining district in California is home and reports having had a very pleasant trip. However he is more enthusiastic over the prospect of Bohemia becoming a great camp than ever before. He says while there has been millions of dollars spent and taken out of the Callahan country the district is not as promising today as is Bohemia, nor is the old '49er camp as large. As a quartz proposition Bohemia is far ahead and is better developed today and as for placer diggings a poor man has no show in Callahan. All the best ground is owned by large companies with expensive plants and even they are to a large extent mining ground long ago gone over by the pick and shovel brigade before the days of dredger and hydraulics. He believes when one tenth of the money that has been spent in mining in the Callahan district is spent in Bohemia the output of gold in the latter place will excel the returns now being obtained in the former. Rab! for Bohemia.

WILL RESUME OPERATIONS.

Supt Lloyd of the Bohemia Gold Mining Co informed the Leader reporter that his company would resume active operations at the mine at once. He has been East for the past two months on business connected with the company during which time operations have been discontinued. Mr. Lloyd informs us that a contract for a 100 foot tunnel on the ledge will be let at once. This company has some very promising claims in the Bohemia district and we are glad to learn that they have not been abandoned altogether.
