THE GRAND CANON OF THE ARKANSAS.

Easiest of access among all the canons of Colorado, being situated on the main line of the Denver & Rio Grande between Canon City and Salida in the front range of the Rockies, it is the most spectacular, awe-inspiring and magnificent.
