SLICED TO PIECES.

DENVER, March 14.—When Phillip Grosz's feet were frozen six weeks ago, and he was taken to the county hospital, it was not supposed that his condition was serious. He had been on a prospecting tour and was caught in a snow storm. After a few days confinement one of his feet was amputated. Later the other was cut off. The first amputation was not successful and a foot of the leg was sawed off. Grosz's disease which first made its appearance six years ago, again manifested itself and one of his hands was taken off at the wrist. The doctors took the other one from him three days later. Last week the leg that was spared at first was carved off above the knee. Yesterday both arms were taken off near the shoulders. One of his ears now shows symptoms of the disease and will be shaved off tomorrow. The case is pronounced one of the strangest ever come in contact with in Colorado, and the staff physicians at the hospital are watching it closely.

GREAT BRITAIN'S TROUBLES CONTINUE

LONDON, March 17.—The depression and discouragement of the British public over the long drawn-out conflict with the Boers in South Africa is steadily increasing. The general discouragement finds fresh fuel in the fact that the Cape Colony rebellion is again flourishing through the "Cape" Dutch were thought to be pacified.

Boer forces under General Maritz have captured two British supply convoys.

It seems to be the general impression that the government suppresses disagreeable news when it may not be supplied from other sources.

AN ICE GORGE IN THE MISSOURI

CHAMBERLAIN, South Dakota, March 18.—The Missouri River at this place went dry for a time Sunday from an ice gorge.

The vast quantity of floating ice in the river makes the situation very dangerous. Another ice gorge of a more permanent nature is liable to form at any time and flood the country by back water, else cut a new channel, either of which would result in great loss of property, and probably life.

TRINITY EPISCOPAL CHURCH BURNED

Trinity Protestant Episcopal church was badly damaged Monday by a destructive fire, which broke out owing to a defective flue, at the northwest corner of the building, at Sixth and Oak streets, Portland. The loss is about \$12,000, covered by \$16,000 insurance. Big holes are burned in the roof, the organ is damaged, and water is standing over the entire floor from end to end. The expensive altar cloths and part of church furniture were pluckily saved by a member of the church choir, Gus Kramer assisted by several women, were sewing in the parish house when the fire started. It is a question if the present church building will be repaired. Several wealthy members of the church think that the time has now arrived to sell the property and build a stone church on the lot owned by Trinity corporation on Washington street, between Seawent and Eighteenth street.

GUEVARRA SURRENDERS

MANILA, March 19.—General Lukban's efforts in influencing Guevarra, who recently issued a proclamation declaring himself the successor of General Lukban in the Island of Samar, to surrender, have been successful. Both General Smith, in command of the United States forces in Samar, and Guevarra have agreed to an armistice to facilitate the collection of Guevarra's men with their rifles, when the formal surrender will be made. The arms will be paid in at the fort. General Smith cables that Guevarra guarantees the absolute peacefulness of his men.

General Chaffee is greatly pleased with what he considers as closing the native insurrection. The resistance in Batangas and Laguna Provinces is practically over. There are daily surrenders there of men and guns. The insurgents have been completely starved into submission by general Bell's aggressive tactics in preventing any exterior assistance from reaching them. Some surprise is expressed at the number of rifles to be turned in by the men under Guevarra, as it was thought there were but 200 in Samar.
