FARM BUTTER MAKING.

At a recent convention of the Illinois Dairy Association W R Hostetter, one of the leading dairymen of Illinois, discussed butter making on the farm, and pointed out that the comparatively low grade of farm butter was due to the small quantity made. He is convinced, however, that good butter can be made on the farm, and in order to do this the dairy house and the surroundings must have excellent drainage and must be so constructed as to get the maximum amount of sunshine. He advises getting the very best tinware for dairy purposes, as it is so much easier to keep good utensils clean. Never buy cheap cans, pails or strainers.

Get a good separator, and use some kind of power for running it as it is exceedingly difficult to maintain a uniform speed when turning by hand. He has no set temperature for cooling cream and churning as so much depends on weather, the dairy house etc. A general rule he likes to ripen his cream at a high temperature and to churn at as low a temperature as possible. He usually churns at 55 degrees in winter and 40 to 45 degrees in summer. The churn must be stopped at just the right time, or when the butter granules are about the size of a grain of wheat. He adds a little salt just before washing. The amount of salt to be used depends upon the taste of the customers. He believes it advisable to try to get customers to use fresh butter, so that it can be delivered once or twice a week. Formerly he had customers who wanted him to pack butter in the winter for next summer's use. Gradually they have all abandoned the practice. He advises putting up butting in neat packages, as this will do much toward making sales.—Dairy World.

SOME SHEEP SENSE.

The more experience one has with sheep the more convinced he becomes that success depends to a large extent upon what might be called good "sheep sense," as distinguished from horse sense, so commonly used. It is impossible to make profits out of sheep unless one possesses or acquires this sense. Such a little thing will sometimes upset all the good work that a man can do. Here is a neighbor who had a fine herd of sheep which he carefully bred and fed, and seemed to do everything for them; but a good deal of his pasture land was low and wet, and the sheep spent about half or three quarters of their time with wet feet. They seem to prefer the low, wet lands, but that was because there was better vegetation there, and not because they liked wet feet. Well, about half the herd became sick, and after a disastrous season the owner woke up to the necessity of fencing off his low, wet lands from the sheep pasture.

WE ARE EATING MORE BEEF.

George M. Rummel, expert in animal industry of the Department of Agriculture, addressing the annual meeting of the Central Short-horn Association, in Kansas City, made the statement that Americans are now eating more beef, comparatively, than ever before, and less pork and mutton. Continuing, he said there were more cattle in the country now, in proportion to population, than ever before, and that the supposition that the number of beef cattle was growing smaller has been based on estimates that must have been very far from correct. Mr Rummel said that the number of beef cattle, not including dairy stock, has shown a steady increase for the last fifty years, a fact that was a cause of great surprise to the Department of Agriculture. In 1850 there were, he said, 491 beef cattle to every 1,000 persons, while now the proportion was 661 to 1,000—Southwestern Stockman.
