COTTAGE GROVE, OREGON.

DESTROYED BY BIG VOLCANOES

Estimated That 40,000 Lives Are Lost in the French West Indies.

ST. LUCIA, B. W. I., May 11.—Further reports of the destruction of St Pierre by volcanic eruption show it to have been one of the most disastrous on record, and over 40,000 lives are lost. Only a few survivors have been found in the vicinity. Other islands were also seriously effected.

PARIS, May 9.—The minister of Marine is in receipt of the following cablegram sent from Fort De France Island of Martinique, last night, by the commander of the French warship Suchet: "I have just returned from St Pierre, which was completely destroyed by an immense mass of fire which fell on the town about 8 o'clock this morning. The entire population (about 25,000 souls) is supposed to have perished. I have brought back the few survivors, about 30. All the shipping in the harbor was destroyed by fire. The eruption continues."

FORT DE FRANCE, Martinique, May 12.—It now seems to be generally admitted that about 30,000 persons lost their lives as a result of the outbreak of the Mount Pelee volcano at St Pierre Thursday last. Careful investigation by competent government officials shows that the earlier reports of the Associated Press were accurate. Briefly put, last Thursday morning the city of St Pierre disappeared within 10 minutes. In a whirling fire vomit from Mount Pelee 30,000 persons were instantly and horribly killed and the volcano, whose ancient crater for more than 50 years had been occupied by a quiet lake in which picnic parties bathed, Suddenly discharged a torrent of fiery mud, which rolled toward the sea engulfing everything before it. The last cabled communication was broken and the doomed city was isolated from the world.

FOR BOHEMIA RAILROAD.

Bill to Grant It Right of Way Across Forest Reserve.

WASHINGTON, May 10.—Senator J H Mitchell has introduced a bill granting a right of way across the Cascade forest reserve for the Oregon & Southeastern Railroad from a point on the western border of the reserve in Lane county, running southwesterly up the valley of the Frank Brice creek, thence up the valley of Champion creek to the base of Grizzly and Grouse summits of the Calipooia mountain.

The bill also grants right of way for such sidetracks, extensions and spurs as may be necessary to reach the various groups of mines in the reservation in Lane and Douglas counties. Under the bill no timber shall be cut by the company for any purpose outside the right of way granted.

LAND MONEY FOR OREGON

Lane County Gets \$645.66 on 2,604,160 Acres.

Secretary of State Dunbar has disbursed to the various counties of the state the sum of \$15,113.55, that amount being the 5 per cent fund derived by the sale of public lands within the state for the year ending June 30, 1901. The money is disbursed to the Counties in proportion to their respective acreage. The apportionment per acre this year was \$0.002470348. Of the entire amount Multnomah county, with one fourth the population of the State, receives the least sum, only \$69.90, since it has an area of only 281,920 acres. Lane county having 2,604,160 acres, receives \$645.66.

THE BOHEMIA RAIL ROAD

Grading is Progressing Rapidly—Three Grading Crews at Work.

Tuesday a Leader representative visited the railroad camps along the O & S E R R and found the work of grading progressing very rapidly. There are three grading crews at work. The first crew is about a mile and a half from town working in a cut at the Newcomb place. This cut is about 250 feet long and 16 feet deep and crosses the road. The second crew is camped at the old Bryant ford on Row River about 3 miles from town and are putting up grade through that section. At the time of our visit this crew had about a mile and a quarter of grade completed. The third crew is grading on the Mosby farm and have about a mile of grading completed, extending from the crossing on Row river southeast through the Mosby place.

The right of way clearing crew is also making rapid progress. It is estimated that by Saturday night that there will be five miles of grade completed.

Mr Le Roy is well known here and we bespeak for him a good trade. Mr Clement returns to Eugene where he will devote his attention to mining interests.
