**A Wet Town.**  
 The city of Portland had a genuine experience of a cloud-burst last Saturday afternoon. The Oregonian says one-half inch of water fell in ten minutes. All traffic was stopped for a short time and great sheets of water poured into cellars and over sidewalks and for a short time the streets presented a woeful appearance.

**Stage Accident.**  
 The Eugene-Florence stage line has added another accident to its record. A Mrs Woods attempted to jump out of the stage and fell under the wheels which passed over her body. The lady however was not seriously injured.

**Another Drowning.**  
 Frank Kirkland was drowned near Jasper last Saturday while engaged in driving down the river a lot of shingle bolts. He was alone when the accident happened and although his comrades heard him hollow several times no attention was paid to his cries until too late owing to the fact that yelling was of frequent occurrence along the river banks among the crew in giving directions and carrying on conversation above the noise of the water.

**Drowned.**  
 Foreman Thos Moore, of the Corvallis saw mill, was drowned in the treacherous waters of the McKenzie, last Saturday. He was engaged in running a drive of logs down the river for Corvallis and stepped off into what he thought was shallow water but which was deeper than he thought and the swift current carried him off his feet and after drifting down the stream for a hundred yards or so he was drawn under one of the numerous whirlpools of that treacherous stream. The McKenzie is noted for its dangers and has an annual crop of drownings. Mr Moore belonged to the K O T M and was said to be insured for \$2000. He leaves a wife and five children living at Corvallis.

**Serious Accident.**  
 Mrs W F Neat and her daughter, Mrs Westcarson met with what nearly proved a fatal accident Monday morning at the railroad crossing near the residence of Mr Edgar King just below town. The ladies were driving a buggy on the road to Saginaw. When they reached the point or curve at the crossing they stopped their team and listened for the cars but not hearing any they proceeded to drive across the track when the engine of a fast freight dashed into view and struck the vehicle, throwing it over the grade with its occupants literally smashing the buggy into kindling wood. The ladies were both badly bruised and the daughter's arm was broken. The unfortunate ladies were immediately brought to town and medical assistance procured when it was found that neither of them was dangerously hurt though their wounds were very painful. The ladies are positive the train did not whistle at the crossing and it would seem that if such was the case the accident was purely the result of criminal carelessness on the part of the engineer. King's point is a dangerous crossing and it is remarkable that accidents do not frequently occur at that place.
