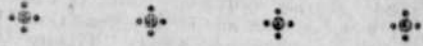

INDIAN WAR VETERANS.

At an adjourned meeting of the Indian War Veterans of 1855 and 1826, held at Independence, August 16, 1902, the following proceedings were had:

On motion of Mayor James Bruce, of Benton county, Ben Hayden was chosen chairman.

On motion of James Hays, of Corvallis, J R Cooper, of Independence, was chosen secretary.

On motion of Mayor Bruce, the Secretary was instructed to communicate with all the County Clerks within the State and ascertain the number of Indian War Veterans and their dependent widows in their respective Counties and report the same to the Adjutant General at Salem.

On motion of D L Hedges, the Secretary was instructed to transmit a copy of these proceedings to all the newspapers within the State with request to publish the same.

On motion the meeting adjourned to meet at Salem, Wednesday, October 1, 1902, and all Indian War Veterans are cordially invited to attend. Chairman, Ben Hayden; Secretary, J R Cooper.

A NEW LUMBER COMPANY.

Articles of incorporations of the Cottage Grove Lumber Co with a capital stock of \$100,000 were filed with County Clerk E U Lee this week. The incorporators are F D Wheeler, F P Phillips and J E Young. The objects and business of the company, as given in the articles of incorporation, shall be to purchase, hold, mortgage, hypothecate and dispose of real estate and timber and to own and operate saw-mills, shingle mills and other machinery and to build, construct and own such buildings, roads, dams and other appliances as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the incorporation. The principal office and place of business is Cottage Grove, Ore. The capital stock is divided into 10,000 shares of par value of \$10 each.

A Fine Property

A fine body of good ore has been struck on the champion claim at a depth of 300 feet from the surface in the face of the old dript which is now about 800 feet long. The find was not unexpected in that it was supposed from surface indications to be a fairly good body of ore but the ore is even richer than expected and now demonstrates the Champion mine is beyond doubt one the best properties in Bohemia. The remarkably good thing about the new find is that the ore is still free milling at that depth which means a present as well as future profit to the Champion people. It is hoped very soon the Champion mills will again be grinding away as of old and her prospects were never brighter for a prosperous year than now.
