

Obituary.
Mrs Grizzella Wooley departed this life at the home of her son, Mr J S Wooley, August 27, 1902, at the advanced age of 85 yrs. 5 mos. 11 days.

Deceased was born in Garrard County, Ky., March 16, 1814. She was married to Wm H Wooley August 13, 1833, and was the mother of ten children. In the fall of 1841, in company with her husband and children, she removed to north Mo. where as pioneers on the frontier of civilization made a comfortable home for their large and growing family. In 1863 the family migrated to Calif. and in 1864 came on to Oregon settling in Lane Co. In the Spring of 1865 her husband lost his life by accidental drowning, near Springfield in this county. A few years after this sad bereavement in company with two of her sons she returned to Calif., but after a short sojourn there she again came to Oregon purchased a small farm on Spencer Creek. After the marriage of her youngest son, J C Wooley, she sold her farm and broke up housekeeping and for nearly 20 years made her home in California with her oldest daughter, Mrs S A Boother. The last two years of her life were spent in the home of her oldest living son, Rev C A Wooley, of Fairmount. She was an earnest Christian and for many years a member of the O P Church. Three sons, one daughter, a goodly number of grand children and great grand children are left to mourn the loss of one they all loved and honored.

School to Open Sept 29th.
Our public school will open on Sept. 29th and from Prof Briggs we learn that in the high school department a few slight changes have been made. The principal will have charge of the 7th and 8th grades in Mathematics, History, and Civics and Geometry and Algebra in the 9th, 10th and 11th grades. Miss White will control the classes in Spelling, Writing and Geography in the 7th and 8th grades and Physiology, Grammar, Book-keeping and Literature in the 9th and 10th. While Miss Lea will have charge of Literature, Physical Geography, Physiology and Language in the 7th and 8th grades and Geology and Rhetoric in the 10th and 11th grades. In this classification the Principal believes he is giving the work to the higher teachers where they have heretofore shown some degree of special fitness for those branches. The grades below the 8th will generally be appointed to the various teachers as heretofore. The teachers in the other rooms have not all arrived yet and their work has not as yet been completely scheduled.
